A. **On a separate sheet of paper, the applicant must handwrite a 250-500 word essay that answers the following question:**

Why do you want to attend Brownell Talbot School, and what do you hope to contribute to the school community?

B. **On another sheet of paper, the applicant must handwrite another 250-500 word essay about ONE of the three following questions:**

1. Have you ever wondered what your best friend thinks about your family? Write a description of your family from that friend's perspective.
2. If you could be any person from the past, who would you be? Explain your choice.
3. Whom do you most admire? What made or makes that person special?

COMPLETING THE MALONE SCHOLARS PROGRAM APPLICATION PROCESS

To complete the Malone Scholars Program application process, the applicant must:

1. Complete both the Brownell Talbot and Malone applications and return them to the school by January 25, 2020. (Admissions Office, 400 N. Happy Hollow Blvd., Omaha, NE 68132)
2. Complete the financial aid application process. To initiate this process, the applicant's parents must complete the Student and School Services (SSS) Parent Financial Statement (PFS). Submit the PFS to SSS in the envelope provided or apply online at your earliest convenience. You will also need to submit a copy of the PFS and your IRS form 1040 for the most recent tax year to the Brownell Talbot Business Office.
