The Catalina Island/Toyon Bay Study Trip *Is an optional, parent-pay activity for Dana Middle School* 7th grade students.

<u>During Back to School Night</u> seventh grade science teachers will present information about the trip and distribute lottery forms.

The trip dates are Friday, March 27–Sunday, March 29, 2020. We have booked space for 75 girls and 75 boys for this year. The trip fee is \$370.00 per student and includes bus transportation from DMS to Long Beach and back to DMS, boat transportation to and from Catalina Island, lodging, activities, meals, and a CIMI/Toyon Bay sweatshirt.

Academic/behavior Requirements – in all classes, registered <u>and</u> wait list students must maintain "S" (satisfactory) or better citizenship marks, earn work habit marks no lower than an "N" (needs improvement), and earn a GPA of 2.0 or better, earning no "Fs". Grades and behavior will be checked at the end of first semester and just prior to the departure date. Parents are reminded to check in to Canvas weekly to review grades and assignments.
