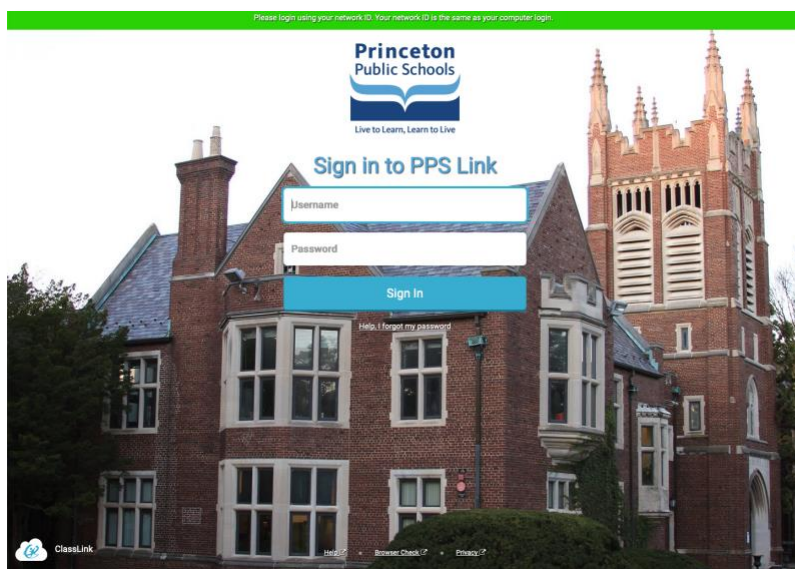


# How Students Login to PowerSchool Learning

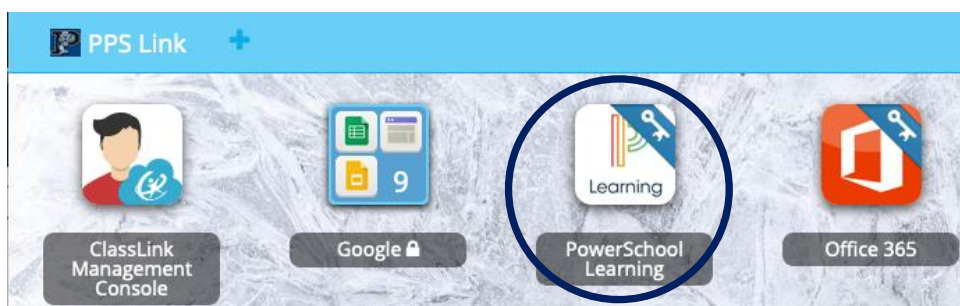


## Method 1: PPS Link

1. Open a web browser and navigate to <http://link.princetonk12.org> (There is also a link on the district website under *Quick Links*.)



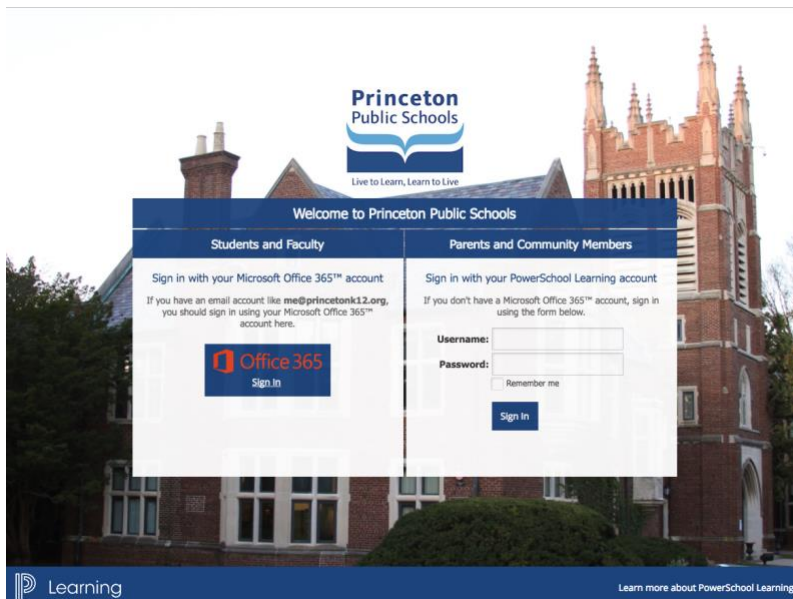
2. Login using the same username and password that you use to login to a computer.



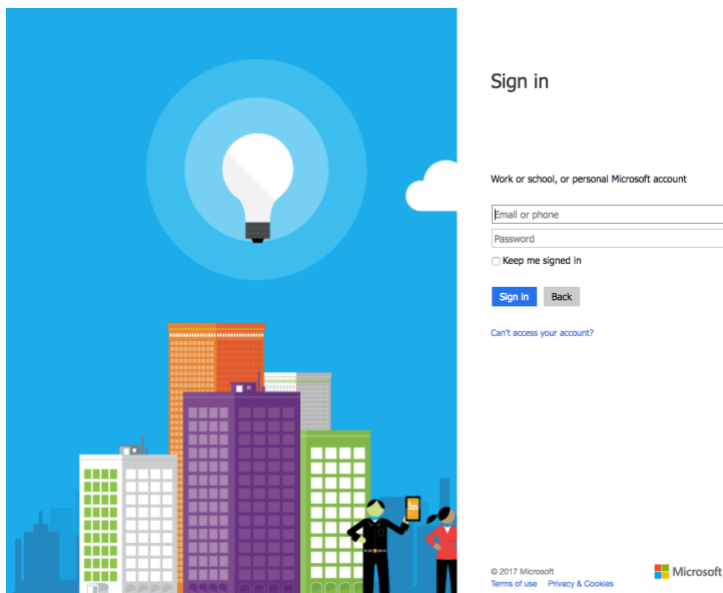
3. Click on PowerSchool Learning.
4. If this is your first time using PPS Link, you will be asked to install an extension. Go ahead and do the installation. This will pass your username and password from PPS Link to the different programs.

## Method 2: Login to PowerSchool Learning Website

1. Open an internet browser and navigate to: <http://pps.learning.powerschool.com>



2. Go to the left-hand side of the screen, under *Students and Faculty*, and click *Sign In*.



3. Your email address begins with the same username you use to login to the computer. Then add @princetonk12.org to the end of your username.

For example: John Smith = jsmith@princetonk12.org

4. The password is the same password you use to login to a computer.
5. When you login, you will be taken to *My Portal* page. Notice the following three (3) sections:

1. **Classes:** This is where you will see all of your classes. To see a class, click on the name of the class.
2. **Calendar and upcoming events:** This second column will show you any upcoming assignments or events that are happening in all of your classes. The color next to each event will correspond with the color next to that same class on the left.
3. **Announcements:** This third column will display any announcements that are posted in any of your classes. The color next to the announcement will correspond with the color next to that same class on the left.
