#### **Fugua School Art Honor Society**

# **Overview**

The purpose of the Fuqua School Art Honor Society is to inspire and recognize students who have shown outstanding ability and motivation in the field of visual art. The chapter seeks to foster excellence and dedication in the visual arts and to further the creative abilities and talents of its members. The chapter also strives to bring art to the attention of the school and greater community, and to increase awareness of art in relation to other areas of the school curriculum.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- 1. Is enrolled as a student in grades 10, 11, or 12;
- 2. Successfully completed at least Introduction to Visual Art;
- 3. Achieved a minimum GPA of 3.2 in visual art courses;
- 4. Meets Fuqua School's minimum standard for overall GPA (not on academic probation);
- 5. Committed no serious behavior violation (level III or higher) throughout the previous academic year nor behaved in a manner that resulted in behavior probation.

# **Application Process**

Complete and submit the Art Honor Society application to the sponsor of the society. The application includes the completion of a portfolio that must contain three original works of art. Two of those may be previous works from class, and one must be a new independently completed work. The portfolio must also contain a brief artist statement explaining their growth as an artist, goals for further work, and the significance of the chosen pieces.

#### Election

Students who meet all eligibility requirements and successfully complete the application process will be elected into the Fuqua School Art Honor Society. They will be eligible to participate in all chapter activities.

# Membership Retention

To retain membership, the student must maintain a minimum 3.2 GPA in visual art classes and continue to meet all eligibility requirements for behavior.

# Application for Admission to the Fuqua School Art Honor Society

In addition to filing this application with the chapter sponsor, you will need to **submit a portfolio** containing **three original works of art**. Two of these works may be previous works completed in conjunction with an art course. One must be a new work completed independently. The portfolio must also include an **artist statement** explaining the works and their significance to the artist.
