1. Review and Approve March Minutes
  - a. March minutes were approved.
  
2. Review School Improvement Plan
  - a. Current year's goals were reviewed.
    - i. HOPE squad will help address the Student Climate survey where only 58% of students reported feeling safe at school.
    - ii. Survey is given to students in grades 3-6.
  - b. Next year's goals were reviewed.
    - i. Goal #1: Students in K-6 will show a 3% increase on DIBELS Pathways of Progress. Teachers and teacher assistants will work together and receive additional training and/or stipends for specific interventions.
    - ii. Goal #2: Students in K-6 will show an increased engagement in STEM subjects through tools such as Nearpod and InfiniD lab. SEL component addresses "social and emotional learning" and will hopefully help with behavioral issues. Will purchase more devices to access Nearpod.
    - iii. Goal #3: Create a HOPE squad at Bountiful Elementary with elected peers. Hope squad members will include 4-6 grade students.
  - c. Total projected funding for 2019-2020 is \$75,594.79. Need to have less than 10% carryover every year.
  
3. Review Current year expenditures
  - a. New technology cart has arrived
  - b. New teacher aid for first grade and a behavioral specialist was hired
  
4. Other items
  - a. Changes to back to school night and first day of school flag ceremony were discussed. Discussed ways to talk to parents about how they can be involved with their child's education.
  - b. Discussed ideas to make the crosswalks and parent drop off more safe for students.
