### AUGUST

- **Register** for the SAT and ACT exams. Be mindful of Registration deadlines or there will be Late Fees.

- Determine if you need to take SAT Subject Tests. Register at [www.collegeboard.org](http://www.collegeboard.org). Be mindful of Registration deadlines or there will be Late Fees.
- **Check out** the schedule of FREE Practice ACT and SAT tests offered in our community by private tutoring organizations such as Chariot Learning, Kaplan or Sylvan on their websites.
- Continue to **visit** colleges as needed.
- **Update and revise** your information in Naviance under the Colleges tab.
- **Complete** the “Letter of Recommendation Profile” and update your “Resume” on Naviance.
- **Potential DI or DII College Athletes** must register at NCAA.org and request a transcript through Naviance.
- **Go to [www.CommonApp.org](http://www.CommonApp.org)** after August 1<sup>st</sup> to begin completing your college applications and essays.
- **Check college websites** for Honors programs and Scholarship opportunities.
- **Be mindful of deadlines** (application and test registration)

### SEPTEMBER

- **Sign up** to attend the college representative presentations when they visit our College and Career Center.
- **Complete** the “Letter of Recommendation Profile” and “Resume” on Naviance. **Speak** with the two teachers to **request letters of recommendation**.
- **See** the Counseling Secretary to schedule an appointment with your School Counselor for your Senior Check-In appointment if you plan to apply **Early Decision** (binding agreement) or **Early Action**.
- Update and revise your information in Naviance under the colleges tab. **Indicate Early Action or Early Decision if you plan to apply early.**
- Continue to **visit** colleges as needed.
- **Go online** to [www.CommonApp.org](http://www.CommonApp.org) to begin completing your college applications and essays.
- **Request** Transcripts on Naviance at least four weeks ahead of earliest due date.
- **Request** test scores online from [www.ACTstudent.org](http://www.ACTstudent.org) for ACT scores and/or [www.collegeboard.org](http://www.collegeboard.org) for SAT scores to be sent to each of the colleges you apply to.
- **Check** college websites for scholarships.
- **Be mindful of deadlines.**

- **Create** an FSA ID at [www.FAFSA.ed.gov](http://www.FAFSA.ed.gov) and complete the FAFSA application which becomes available on October 1<sup>st</sup>.

### DECEMBER

- **Complete Google Doc** to Request your Midyear report card to be sent to the colleges you applied to.
- **Complete** Dollars for Scholars Application and check Naviance and college websites for other scholarship applications.

### FEBRUARY

- **Write thank you notes to faculty who wrote letters of recommendation for you.**
- **Remember** to Request your Midyear report card to be sent to the colleges you applied to.
- **Check** Naviance and college websites for other scholarship applications.

### MARCH

- **Visit Colleges for Accepted Student Days to Compare and Contrast.**
- **Request** a meeting with the department you applied to and/or request to sit in on a class with a student representative from that department. This will help you to decide which college feels right for you!
- **Check** college websites for scholarship applications.

### APRIL

- **Visit** Colleges for Accepted Student Days to Compare and Contrast.
- **Request** a meeting with the department you applied to and/or request to sit in on a class with a student representative from that department. This will help you to decide which college feels right for you!
- **Prepare** to make your decision as to which college you will attend by May 1<sup>st</sup>.

### MAY

- **Pay** college deposit by May 1<sup>st</sup>.
- **Complete** Senior Graduation Survey in Naviance.
- **Check** your college website for Orientation Registration, Housing Information to request room-mates and dorms, and Meal Plan options.

### JUNE 2019

- **Complete** Senior Graduation Survey in Naviance.
- **Go** online to [www.collegeboard.org](http://www.collegeboard.org) to request your AP Scores to be sent to the college you will attend.
- **Go** online to FLCC to request your transcript to be sent to your college if you registered and paid for SUNY Gemini credits during high school.
- **Go** online to RIT.edu to request your transcript to be sent to your college if you registered and paid for Project Lead the Way courses after sitting for the exams.
- IB students should **contact** the main office to have your IB exam scores sent to the college you plan to attend.
- **Plan** to attend Graduation Rehearsal on Thursday, June 25<sup>th</sup>.
- **Attend** Graduation on Friday, June 26, 2019.
