The FCCLA middle level chapters of Rankin County School District are delighted to announce a leadership opportunity for its young leaders. The FCCLA middle level chapters are hosting a trip to Disney World February 14-17, 2020 for students to participate in the Disney Youth Education Series Program. FCCLA students will participate in the *Managing your Personal Brand* program at Disney's Hollywood Studios. Activities will include guided discussion on how students can distinguish themselves and cultivate professional and personal success. This program helps young students recognize cause and effect between behaviors and how others perceive them as individuals. These skills are critical for effective leadership.

The cost of this program is \$600 for each student, advisor, or chaperone. This includes transportation and driver's tip, program t-shirt, leadership program fees which include a two day park pass, accommodations, and lunch and dinner in the parks for two days.

Accommodations include breakfast every morning. Student rooms will be quad occupancy and chaperone/sponsor rooms will be double occupancy. Beyond the program fees, attendees will only be expected to bring food money for the two travel days and for any souvenirs they wish to purchase in the parks. We recommend \$35 a day for food for the travel days.

45 students and 11 advisors or chaperones will be chosen from FCCLA middle level chapters in the district. Each school will have spots assigned to them based on a percentage of active members. Decisions on attendees will be made through an application process. Students or chaperones who have been chosen to participate must pay a NON-REFUNDABLE deposit of \$200 no later than Friday, October 4. A second payment of \$200 will be due no later than Friday, November 8. The balance will be due no later than Friday, January 10. *Details for deposits are included in the application.*
