Reminder Notice to Parents

Thank you for your continued support with entering and exiting the school safely at the beginning and end of each day. As you know pupil safety is our primary concern.

As a reminder please can you ensure that **you**:

- Do not park in the coned bus bay area.
- Follow staff instructions when exiting the car park to allow staff to enable the buses to exit the coned area safely.
- Drive carefully and with correct regard for the users of the site.
- Drive at a maximum of 5 miles per hour.
- **Drive safely**, with a full awareness of pedestrians and other vehicles around you.
- Park to ensure you can **DRIVE OUT** of your space and **NOT REVERSE** into the road where pupils and parents may be crossing. If you must reverse, please refrain from doing so until the site has emptied.
- Do not arrive on to the Gwyn site until 2.45pm and park safely to ensure we can exit older pupils safely from 3.05. The gates will be opened at this time. Pick up from the Nant building will begin at 3.05 and is for Nant children only.
- Do not arrive too early to queue at the gates to enter the site, as this will cause problems, which can result in congestion on the public highway.
- Pupils from the Gwyn building will not be released until parents arrive. Please do not be worried if you are running a little late because of these new arrangements.
- Park in designated parking spaces and drop off bays only, do not double park or block other drivers. If you are directed to do park in an alternative space, please do not leave until it is safe to do so.
- Only use disabled bays if you are the correct holder of a disability blue badge
- If you are walking to school or are able to walk as an alternative to using your car, the gate from Llewellyn Street on the new footpath will be open at 2.50pm.
- Ensure that children who are collected from school are fully supervised while they exit the site, including in car parks and on footpaths.
- If your child walks home, please ensure they have good 'road sense' and use the resources on this website as a guide www.roadwise.co.uk if you are unsure.
- Pupils' behaviour on school and public transport must be exemplary and we encourage parents to revisit this with their children who use these facilities.
