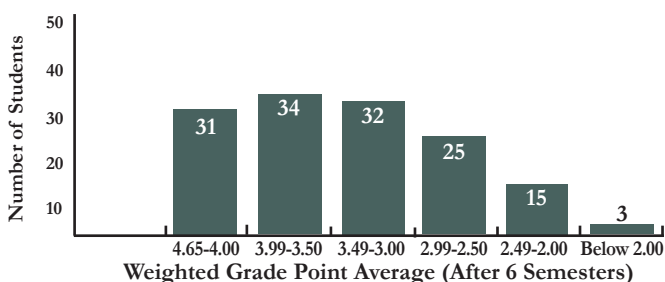

Curriculum

Our curriculum includes an extensive list of Honors and Advanced Placement courses. NWC High School challenges students to achieve their full potential.

The current school policy does not provide for rank. Cumulative GPA is determined by the grade received at the end of each semester using a traditional system of:

A=4.0, B=3.0, C=2.0, D=1.0, F=0

Advanced Placement and Honors courses, designated AP and Hon on the transcript, are weighted by adding a .5 bonus to each grade, e.g., A=4.5. The highest possible grade point average is 4.78.
