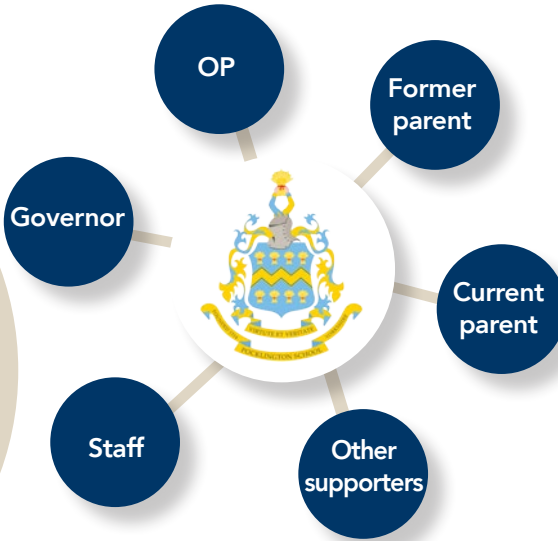
Helping to inspire our students, and each other, for life

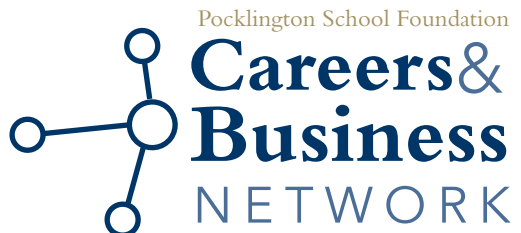
