She said, "Coming into Marianapolis as a freshman, my coach pointed at the banner on the wall and told me that one day, with a strong work ethic and dedication, that it very well could be my name hanging there too. ### STEPHON BAXTER '19



In a February 27th game against Rivers School, senior Stephon Baxter of Worcester, MA became the seventh male in Marianapolis history to reach 1,000 points in his basketball career.

Baxter has been on the boys' varsity team for three seasons and averaged 16.4 points per game, 2.8 assists per game, and 1.9 steals per game this past season. He reached the milestone in a NEPSAC Class B quarterfinal win. The team ended the season at the semi-finals with a loss to Canterbury School.

Other male basketball players from Marianapolis to reach 1,000 points in their senior year include Kevin Goudreau '83, Mark St. Amour '92, Fernando Rivera '92, Mark Alexander '06, Kristian Medina '12, and Tyler Burton '19 who achieved it in his junior year.
