Program Descriptions

English as a Second Language Classes (ESL) Metro South offers ESL classes at many different levels to adult learners from a variety of countries. We have classrooms in Richfield, Edina, Bloomington, and Eden

Pond Family School

Prairie.

Metro South partners with the Pond Family Center in offering family literacy classes through the Family School program. Parents study English and participate in a parenting education class, while their 3 or 4 year-old child attends preschool.

Diploma Programs for Adult Learners

Metro South offers an Adult Diploma program with classes in the daytime and evening for adult learners who are working to complete the requirements of a high school diploma. Upon completing the requirements, students will receive a Bloomington diploma.

GED

Metro South offers preparation in all four areas of the General Education Development (GED) exam. These classes, small groups, and tutors help learners improve their reading, writing, and math skills in a supportive environment.

College Preparation

Metro South assists adult learners with specific goals of learning to read better, learning math skills, and improving writing abilities. Some learners need to improve their skills before taking a trade test or school entrance exam.

Classes are offered Monday through Thursday; daytime and evening schedules available Students must be at least 17 years old and must take a reading test at registration. An alternative class will be offered to

qualify for this program.
