### Student Illness

Many of our students immune system is compromised. In an effort to support all students medical needs, should your child exhibit any of the symptoms listed below please **do not** send your child to school. Students must **stay at home** until completely well, including a 24-hour fever-free period. If your child becomes ill at school, **pick your child up immediately following a phone call.**

#### **Symptoms include:**

- Thick, colored discharge from nose
- Persistent and productive cough
- Red or runny eyes, persistent sneezing
- Fever suggested by flushed, warm skin
- Sore throat
- Diarrhea
- Nausea/vomiting
- Open sore
- Any rash abnormal to your child

### START Parent Learning Module

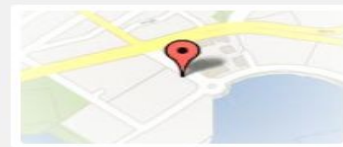

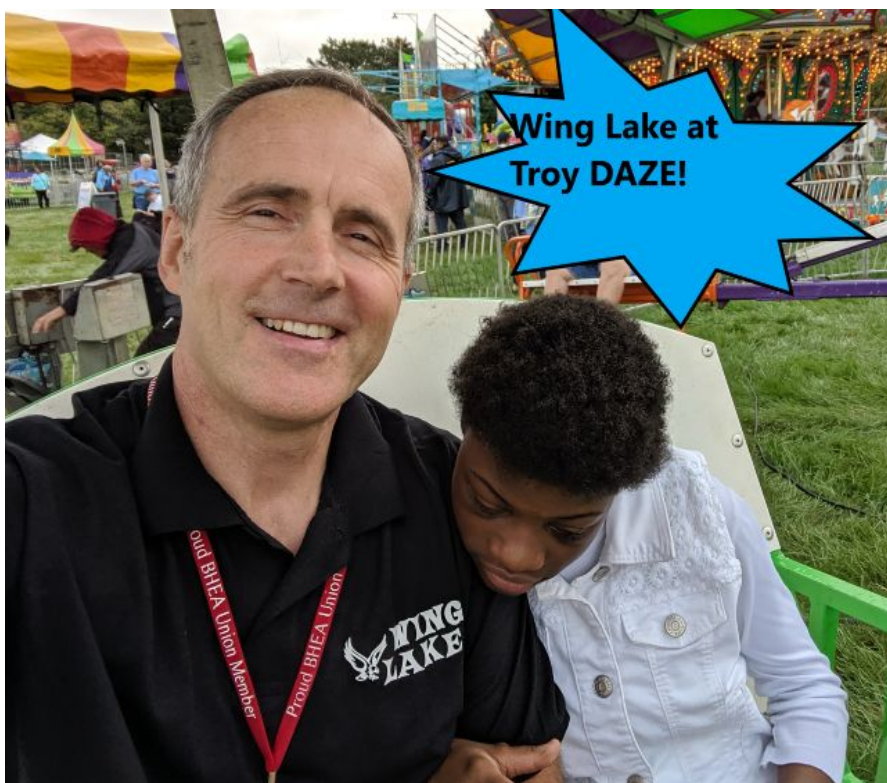
