Ukulele

- Students will play soprano ukuleles owned by the Forest Trail Music Department.
- Students may bring their own ukulele to the class, but it is not required.
- No experience is necessary to join the Ukulele Club. Class projects are adjusted for skill level.
- At-home practice is encouraged if the student owns his/her own ukulele (**not required**). If you choose to purchase one for home practice, I recommend soprano or concert sizes (other sizes are available, but sopranos are best for younger learners). Strait Music in Austin has a good selection in their store. Contact me if you have questions about purchasing.
