**All Utah colleges and universities accept the ACT.** If you are planning on going out of state, check the admissions requirements of the school you plan on attending to see if they require the ACT or SAT or if the writing portion of the ACT is mandatory.

## OTHER IMPORTANT TEST DATES

### What is an Index Score?

It is a number that represents your ACT/SAT score and your GPA.

### Why is it important?

Colleges and scholarships use it to determine your college readiness. The higher your score, the more likely you will get into a more selective college and/or qualify for scholarships
