#### Board Member Appointment

Mrs. Randee Sims was appointed to the Board of Education. Her term will continue until the General Election in April 2021.

#### Lisle High School Academic Achievement for the 2018-2019 School Year

The Lisle High School Administrative Team presented the academic, social emotional, and attendance data for the 2018-2019 school year. Principal Howard shared highlights such as 126/127 students, or 99%, graduated in the Class of 2019. In addition, an overview of the Advanced Placement courses and accompanying data was shared along with data for the Performance Test Series (SAT). Lisle High School students far exceeded the State Average on each of the three Performance Test Series. The Administration is pleased with the growth and progress, however, recognize there is still work to be done to support students in furthering their growth. To accomplish this, options for building course structure and supports for targeted interventions are being explored.

The Administration also reviewed social emotional data and information. As part of their efforts to support new students and freshmen, the Administrative Team started a home visit program to ensure all students felt welcome to the school. Other programs such as Learning to Breathe and new VR resources are integrated into the students' day as well to support student social-emotional health.

#### Lisle Elementary School Update

While it was a tight schedule, teachers and volunteers worked tirelessly to prepare our new learning spaces for students. The hard work paid off and Lisle Elementary School welcomed students and families for the first time on the first day of school on August 14, 2019.
