\_\_\_\_ February 1, 2020. Please submitted a complete application, a copy of your grade and a photograph Head Shot for fall 2020 and mailed to the address at the bottom of page **NO EXTENSION** will be granted. The deadline date is the U.S. Postal date indicated above. Please affix your name and home address to the back of a Head shot photograph. Faxed or E-mail submissions will not be accepted.

**Initial**

\_\_\_\_ The school official's signature is required to attest to that the applicant has graduated from school or about to graduate, has applied to a college or university, and has been accepted or anticipates an acceptance or you are already attending a college or university. This sheet must be submitted with application.

**Initial**

\_\_\_\_ The applicants must provide written evidence of acceptance to a college or university; it must be received prior to the application deadline. Must have a GPA 2.5 minimum of maximum of 4.0 GPA \_\_\_\_\_

\_\_\_\_ The applicants must provide (2) letters of references from a principal, guidance counselor, and one from a community person, other than a family member. All letters must be current in 2019- 2020.

\_\_\_\_ The applicants must submit a 300 words essay, typed double space.

Freshman year student, Why Should Young People get involved in Politics?

Sophomore students must submit an essay on "Leadership and Service. Junior/ senior year, A College Education Provide Me Choices. "I", "to" "a" will not be considered a word count.

\_\_\_\_ The complete application form with all required signatures, letters of references and Proof of acceptance by college or university must be received on or before February 1, 2020. (Class schedule with ID must be provided prior to a check being issued to winners by August 1, 2020 ).
