 - Would be offered in conjunction with summer school to add TSI remediation as well
- TSI Testing Schedule
 - TSI Writing Testing Date?
 - Suggested to have first attempt by December to remediate in the spring
 - Students may have to test on Chromebooks – Amanda to confirm requirements with EFC testing center
 - EFC would need to know if DIRW is needed by April to register the students
 - Could be offered during summer school as well
 - All students must be TSI Reading and Writing met by April 1st of 9th grade
 - All students must be TSI Math met by April 1st of 11th grade
 - Developmental courses are final option that can be offered during summer
 - High school will be responsible for cost (\$177 per class)
 - Tentative numbers will be requested in late January/early February
 - All students can now get into eConnect
 - Diagnostic and ABE Summaries can be found on eConnect in Current Credit Student menu under My Personal Information
 - TSI reading tutorials to begin next week (students ranging 341-350)
 - Goal to test early October if they show progress
 - Next group hopes to test in November before Thanksgiving
 - Embedding TSI prep across the year was successful
 - SGHS currently uses the 11-minute charge
 - SGHS needs to submit testing request forms to Amanda
 - TSI diagnostics needed
- Advising Sessions
 - Amanda will meet with students at least once per semester on your campus (group or individual)
 - Amanda to contact Cash and Acevedo to schedule
 - eConnect vs. eCampus orientation early in the semester
 - Individualized probation meetings will be held as needed
 - Students are doing fairly well thus far
- Student celebrations/concerns
 - SGHS will send CE course set up for MAPS class so they can use eCampus
 - HS can request CE courses so that students can continue to use eCampus during the spring
 - SGHS to get facilities revamped to look like a high performing school
 - Working on comprehensive list of changes needed
