Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE) Classroom Volunteer:

We have opportunities for volunteers to serve as in-class support within our Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE) classes. ECFE classes are for parents and children ages birth through 4 years old and take place at the Education Center and multiple outreach sites across the community. We are always looking for great volunteers to join in on the fun!

Elementary and Middle Schools:

We have opportunities for volunteers at each of our 6 elementary schools and at Central Middle School. Opportunities vary by school and range from one-on-one literacy or math tutors to office support and playground and cafeteria volunteers.

Little Eagles Preschool Volunteers At our Little Eagles Preschool:

We have opportunities for volunteers to work with our youngest readers as preschool literacy tutors or providing general classroom support. These classes consist of 3-, 4- and 5-year-old students. Volunteers in these positions work with small groups or individual students on literacy topics such as writing, reading, speaking, and the alphabet. Volunteers also engage students through play and provide assistance with activities and art projects. Preschool classroom opportunities are available at the Education Center, Lower Campus Preschool Center, and Cedar Ridge Elementary.
