DANCE POLICIES:

- 1) Students must purchase his/her own ticket under his/her own name and ID card at the ASB windows at lunch.
- 2) On the Friday prior to the dance, please check for your name on the GUEST LIST that will be posted outside ASB. Only students appearing on the GUEST LIST will be admitted.
- 3) Each EHS student is allowed to bring one guest. The GUEST PASS on the reverse side of this form must be filled out completely with all required signatures. The EHS student is responsible for his/her own guest and must enter the dance together.
- 4) Tickets are nontransferable and nonrefundable.
- 5) Students and guests must have a photo ID to enter the dance.
- 6) All dance attendees may be subject to search upon entry.
- 7) Students should be sure to have all items needed for the evening as they enter. Students will not be able to go back to cars to retrieve items once admitted to the dance. There is no exit and re-entry at dances. Once entering a dance, students are not allowed to leave until 30 minutes prior to the end of the dance.
- 8) Students are expected to DANCE appropriately. Lap dancing, freaking, and grinding have been determined inappropriate at EHS dances.
- 9) DRESS CODE STILL APPLIES. Students dressed inappropriately will not be admitted. **Homecoming Attire: Semi-Formal**
- 10) Students who are in possession of, or under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be removed and their parents will be notified. Administrators may utilize a "breathalyzer" to randomly check students for alcohol usage.
- 11) Students must be picked up or leave the dance site immediately following the conclusion of the dance.

Failure to abide by dance policies and school guidelines will result in immediate removal from the dance and parent; will be contacted for pick-up.

Parent Notification & Refund Policy:

I give my approval for my son/daughter to attend the **Homecoming Dance at the EHS GYM**. Under the provisions of Educational Code 1081.5 all persons attending shall be deemed to have waived all claims against the District or the State of California for injury, accident, illness, or death occurring during or by reason of the activity.

Should it be necessary for my child to receive medical treatment, I hereby give the school personnel permission to use their judgment in obtaining medical assistance for my child. I hereby give school personnel my permission to select a physician and permit that physician to institute the necessary treatment for my son/daughter.

I hereby give school personnel permission to contact me should my son/daughter violate school directives or be in the possession of, or under the influence of alcohol or drugs. I also accept the responsibility of coming to the dance site to take custody of my son/daughter in the event that school personnel calls me.

I understand that all school policies and rules are in full effect and enforced for dances. Students who are noncompliant with school policies and rules are subject to school discipline measures, including but not limited to removal of dance privileges for the remainder of the school year, Saturday School, suspension and expulsion.

Tickets are NONREFUNDABLE and NONTRANSFERRABLE.

GUEST RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. A photocopy of a picture ID or license must be attached to this completed pass. The same ID must be shown in order to enter the dance.
2. The student and guest must attend the dance with each other, and enter into the facilities at the same time. If the guest arrives later than the student, and the student has already entered the dance, the guest may not enter. Under no circumstances will a guest be admitted into a dance without his/her host.
3. Guest passes are not interchangeable. Pass must correspond with student's ID or they will not be admitted. All students and their guests must show their ID to enter the dance. Removal from the dance may be a result from one or more of the following: possession of or under the influence of alcohol/ drugs, fighting, failure to follow direction of chaperones, or any other form of disrespect or inappropriate behavior. Anyone found to be in possession or under the influence of alcohol/drugs will be removed from the dance and his/her parents will be notified. Law enforcement may be contacted.
4. **Guest age requirements: Guests must be at least a high school student but no guests allowed over the age of 20.**
