## Note from our Principal, Mrs. Rachel Greer

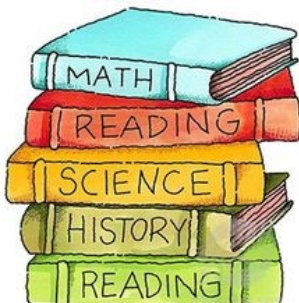
