OUR LOCATION



Covenant Day School is located in Matthews, N.C., a large suburban town located in south Charlotte. *FamilyCircle* Magazine ranked Matthews, N.C. in the top ten Best Towns for Families in 2015 with "great schools, housing, and community spirit."

Charlotte, "The Queen City," is among the top 20 largest cities in America and is the nation's second largest banking center, behind New York City. The city is home to the headquarters of six Fortune 500 companies, the NFL's Charlotte Panthers, the NBA's Charlotte Hornets, the NASCAR Hall of Fame, the U.S. National Whitewater Center, and several colleges and universities.

ACADEMICS

Covenant Day School is a TK-12 Christ-centered, college-preparatory school where academic excellence and a biblical worldview are blended without compromise. Since 2006, the year of our first graduating class, Covenant Day School has had 20 National Merit Finalists and more than 40 national Merit Commended students. Two students have been named UNC Morehead-Cain Scholars. Graduates have been accepted to some of the nation's leading colleges and universities including Cornell University, University of Pennsylvania, University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill, Georgia Institute of Technology, Harvard University, University of Virginia, Baylor University, Duke University, and more. Covenant Day offers more than thirty honors courses and more than 15 Advanced Placement courses at the high school level. Lower school and middle school students consistently outperform students in national standardized achievement tests. Covenant Day School is accredited by SACS/AdvancED and Christian Schools International.

Through Covenant Day School's restoration and sustainability initiative, students have had the opportunity to develop practical, hands-on experience in a variety of areas. Several of these initiatives have garnered national attention. These initiatives give students the opportunity to be salt and light locally and globally. Community service is a key emphasis from lower school until a student graduates. Students have volunteered at local elementary schools, Habitat for Humanity, Operation Christmas Child, CMPD Christmas Explorer's Project, Samaritan's Feet, and more.

FINE ARTS



Through our fine arts program, students are given the opportunity to explore their creative side. Student artwork is exhibited on the campus as well as in the Charlotte and Matthews communities. Students can get involved by playing an instrument in our band, performing in a school musical or drama, singing in a choir concert or with one of our a cappella groups, participating in Celebration of the Arts, or displaying their artwork at the ArtWalk Student Art Exhibit. The opportunities are endless!

ATHLETICS

Covenant Day athletics provides a setting for developing and exercising personal character, sportsmanship, self-discipline, leadership, and athletic ability. Covenant Day is a member of the North Carolina Independent Schools Athletic Association (NCISAA) and in the Charlotte Independent Schools Athletic Association conference (CISAA). More than 75% of high school students participate in at least one sport. The athletic program currently offers more than 40 teams in 14 sports.

WORKING AT CDS

Covenant Day School is pleased to be able to offer our faculty and staff salaries that are competitive with both public and private schools. Covenant Day provides a host of other benefits including medical, dental and vision coverage, short and long term disability, life insurance, and accidental death and dismemberment insurance. We also offer an optional flexible benefits plan for qualified pre-tax medical/dental expenses and a pre-tax retirement 403(b)(7) savings plan. In addition, for qualifying faculty and staff, tuition remission and educational assistance for approved graduate programs are available. Teachers are also provided a laptop with support. In addition to competitive compensation and benefits, the school provides licensure benefits to full-time faculty.

LEGACY CAMPAIGN

In the fall of 2014, Covenant Day School kicked off Phase 1 of Legacy, a \$14 million capital campaign. Elements of this phase included a new lower school playground, a 2,200 square foot fitness center (both completed in October 2015), and a 56,000 square foot state-of-the-art, high-tech high school facility, which opened in August 2016.
