

**Minutes of the  
November 12, 2018  
Regular Meeting of the  
China Spring Independent School District Board of Trustees**

The China Spring I.S.D. Board of Trustees met in a regular meeting on Monday, November 12, 2018. Superintendent Dr. Marc Faulkner, Assistant Superintendent Dr. Kevin Pitts, Max Rutherford, Kristen Dutschmann, and Kim Coe met with the following trustees: Rick Hines, Jeff Bradburn, Holly Dunham, Bubba Galvan, Trey Oakley and Matt Penney. 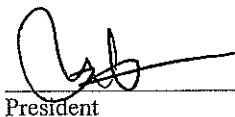

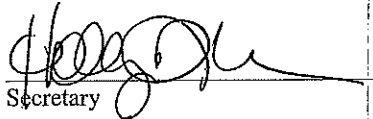
**17. Adjourn (Action Item)**
