

McCallie Technology Camp-Modeling, Coding, & Modding

We are so excited you are attending the McCallie Technology Camp-Modeling, Coding, & Modding! Thank you for enrolling in our camp. We are committed to helping all participants learn and enjoy the camp.

Camp drop-off will be in front of the McCallie Gameroom. Follow signs to Day Camp; a staff member will be waiting in front of the Gameroom.

Camp will begin promptly each day at 9:00 a.m. There will be a staff member available each morning beginning at 8:00 a.m. for early drop in front of the McCallie Gameroom. Please make sure your child brings a book, crossword puzzle, handheld gaming device as they will not be permitted to play on the computer/internet during early drop off. If you arrive after 9:10, you may send your child to our classroom which is in Walker Hall. (Walker Hall is located across the street from Gameroom. Students can walk up the 2 flights of steps and there will a door to left to enter Walker Hall. Once inside, our classroom is the first one on the left.)

Camp ends at 3:30 p.m. Pick up will be either outside the McCallie Gameroom at the end of camp at 3:30 or at the McCallie Lake (outdoor swimming pool) by 4:15 p.m. Please make sure to check out with one of us when picking up your child from the lake.

After the lake, your child will be taken to after care in the McCallie Gameroom in the Student Center and can be picked up there between 4:20-5:00. After 5:00, there is a late fee of \$25.

Please note the road in front of the Gameroom will only be open during the mornings and afternoons for drop-off and pick up, and not all day.

We will have a morning and afternoon break if you would like to send your child a snack. Snacks will not be provided.

Bring a swimsuit and towel if planning to swim at the end of camp each day. Remember that lunch is included.

In the event of inclement weather during swim time, we will not go to the McCallie Lake and a rain plan will take effect. Campers will be taken to the Game Room from 3:30-4:15 instead of the Lake and may be picked up there during that time.

Please make sure to fill out a prescription form if your child will be bringing any medication, i.e. an epipen to camp. The form should be filled out and included with prescription.
