I am more excited and more confident about St Joes than ever. There is an increasing synergy and purpose among the folks that make up St Joes. Meaningful conversations between generations ensure that our virtues and

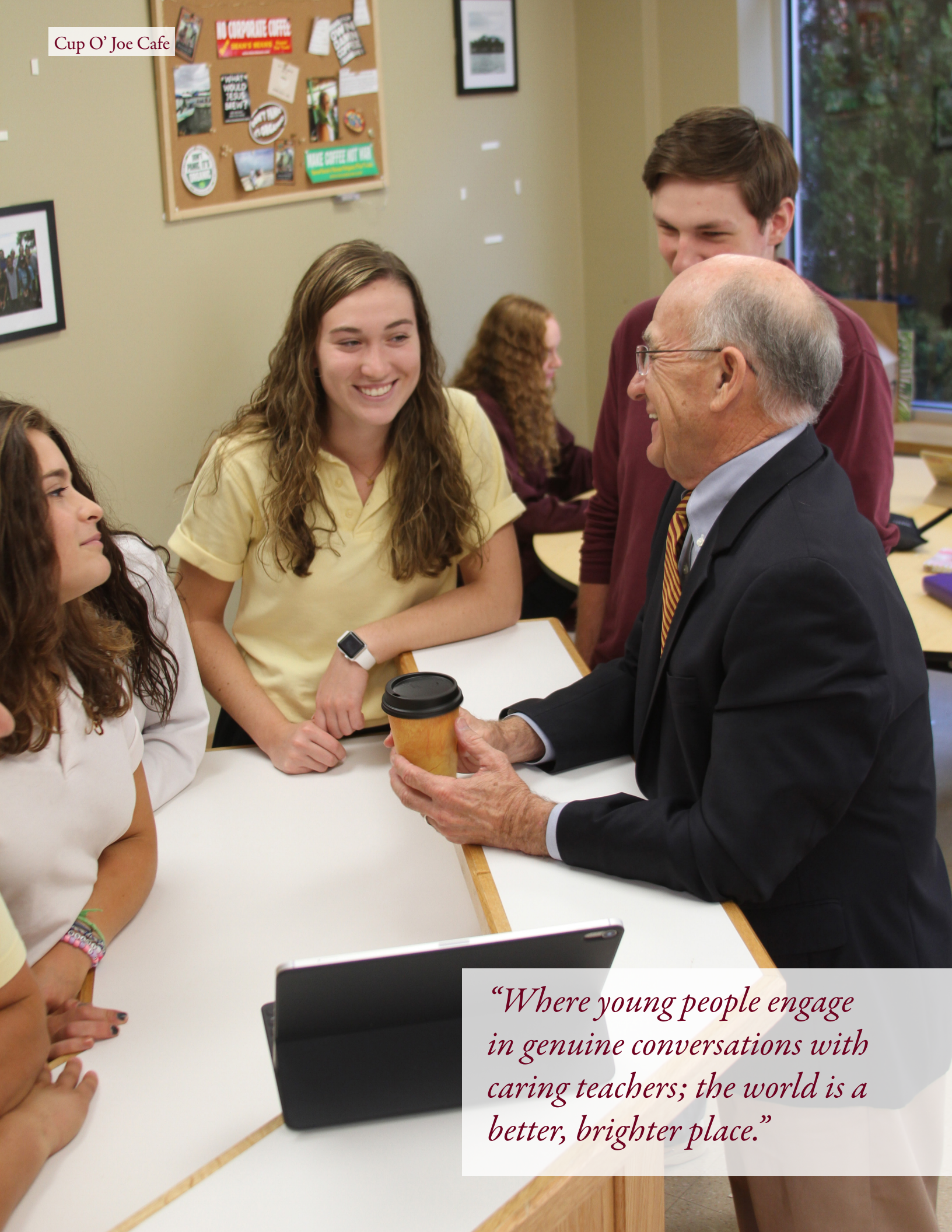
values are fit for the future. When we speak of community, we speak about people. We have always had good people—students, parents, teachers, staff. The Board of Directors assumes demonstrable leadership responsibility for operations; our teachers and administrators have embraced a liberating approach to innovation and entrepreneurship; and admissions and college counseling and faculty have collaborated in new ways to ensure our college preparatory education is seamless and comprehensive.

A majority of our students plan careers in science and health related fields. Our conversations with these students have led to new programs in engineering and computer science, in environmental and life sciences. Their concerns drive new educational support programs and college readiness training. The Health and Wellness Center has energized wellness initiatives throughout the school. The boardwalk did more than invite students into nature; our students have improved those neglected wetlands. The student-led Kairos retreats and our Pizza and Prayer initiatives have made Faith an action verb. Eight hundred students contributed over 36,000 hours of service work last year. At the same time, the Francis Xavier Program connected our students with folks in Peru, Nicaragua, Puerto Rico, China, Rome, New Orleans. We grow.

I often say someone did something right here and each class passes it on. More accurately, each class grows that special something. There is a vitality here—strengthened by our staff’s one hundred and fifty voices proposing new ideas and directions—that is exponentially increasing our readiness for the future coming at us. Where young people engage in genuine conversations with caring teachers, the world is a better, brighter place. We grow, together—for others: St Joes.

IGH SCHOOL

Where you go to high school matters! This is such an impactful statement both as a parent and student. I had the advantage of graduating from St Joes as a member of the class of 1988. Afterward, I went to an out-of-state college, where I then started my career, met a pretty girl, married, and started a family away from home. Fortunately, my career led us back to Connecticut in 2008.

Returning home after 20 years is a different experience. While much had changed - new businesses, new families, new neighborhoods - much had stayed the same, which was comforting, and confirmed we made the right decision.

My wife and I have the privilege and responsibility of raising four daughters. When we discussed high school with our oldest child, we wanted it to be a unanimous decision. St Joes was top on the list as well as other public provided options. But once I returned to the campus and re-connected with the St Joes family, I was amazed to find the foundation and tradition of the school was still very much intact, even better it was rock solid and thriving.

That foundation isn't something that you can measure in buildings, athletic fields, square feet, or acreage. It is the people, the feeling, the spirit of the community. Walking the halls during the open house instantly overwhelmed us and reminded us that this is still a very special place. So many faculty members from my years in school were still teaching, and alumni were with their own children or speaking to prospective parents about their experiences.

Not only was the special feeling still there, it was amazing to see the progress that was and is still being made to the infrastructure, academics, faculty, and administration. Another striking observation was the number of alumni that returned home to choose St Joes as a career. As we engaged with the "new" leadership and faculty, they were eager to share the future plans for the school and equally interested in my experience as a student and what made my time at the school special.

The evolution within St Joes has provided so many diverse opportunities for our children which they have fully embraced. They do not run home right after the last bell - we don't expect to see them until dinner! Their interests and activities range from Student Council, Drama Club, Soccer, Basketball, Peer Ministry, and so much more! These interests are all initiated on their own and have never been forced. Even more impressive is the fact that they participate in these groups with different friends and peer groups. Diversity in learning and community are the pillars of personal growth and have made us so proud as parents. We thank St Joes for fostering the inclusive faith-based community that makes it special.

As of May 2019, we have a total of five St Joes alumni in our extended family, with the sixth planned for 2020, seventh planned for 2023, and our youngest just four short years away from enrolling. I will confirm and echo sentiments often said by Dr Fitzgerald, "where you go to high school matters, and with whom you go matters."

Our children enter St Joes with blank pages and plenty of ink to write a great story about high school guided by a faith-based compass that prepares them well for college and life. We couldn't be more confident and pleased we chose St Joes!

LEARNING TOGETHER:

St Joes Hosts Middle School Workshops to Highlight the School's Engaging Curriculum.

The St Joseph High School Enrollment Management model reflects the investment of each member of our school community in the progress of our school's future. In 2018, St Joe's Admission Team collaborated with our talented faculty to create a new initiative – middle school workshops. Faculty happily opened their doors, current Cadets served as amiable role models, and middle school visitors got a glimpse of the vibrant community that exists at St Joes.

Newsletters, post cards and even open house events cannot fully capture the authentic learning and deep engagement that happens daily in our classrooms. As students begin their high school search, St Joe's workshops offer an opportunity for visitors to work side by side with our current Cadets to tackle an academic project. Thus far, 130 7th grade students have participated in Mandarin, Pottery, Theology, Biology, Health and Wellness, Theater and Engineering workshops led by our faculty.

There is something about exploring ethical dilemmas in conversation with peers, getting your hands dirty while creating a work of art and learning student-led best practices for Mandarin pronunciation that allows our visitors to explore their high school fit in a more profound way. This year, we hope to expand our selection of workshops and open our doors to additional schools and potential students. Our goal is to provide the opportunity for students to make an informed decision about their next educational step. Everyday there is something special happening within our classrooms; we look forward to sharing more of these experiences with future students.

After reflecting on my eighth St Joseph High School graduation this past June, I have come to solidify my strong belief on the immense value of our diploma. I was truly moved as I remembered the young freshmen who came into our building one September four years ago and witnessing them leaving as young men and women of virtue and great promise.

Why do the students at St Joes do so well? Because the people who make up the faculty and staff at St Joes recognize that education is multidimensional and holistic. Education occurs both inside a classroom, as well as on an athletic field and on a service trip. The faculty come to work each day because they share a common bond - a love of St Joes and the students who attend here. Faculty constantly assess and examine the curriculum and the course offerings to assure collegiate success for our students. They challenge our students, creating rigorous lessons and activities that deepen their thinking and connects to our global society. Students here are seen as individuals. Their differences collaborate to create the unique community that St Joes is known for. The classroom is constantly evolving to meet the future needs of the students.

Extracurriculars are also an important part of the lives of our students. From Athletics to Engineering to Drama, our activities work together to offer students the opportunity to be part of a team or club and learn the valuable lessons of working together. These extracurriculars are an important part of the educational experience of our students. Many students and alumni can easily detail the life lessons learned on the football field or behind the scenes of our spring musical.

While we graduate students who can critically think, collaborate, and create, we more importantly graduate students of integrity. The faith and morals of our Catholic education help mold our students into young men and women who are not only kind and compassionate, but are also ready to make the world a better place. Our students dedicate themselves to helping others, as they see the value in connecting with others, especially those less fortunate. St Joes fosters the education of the whole person, and community service is a valuable part of the education of a young adult.

The point of education is to create independent thinkers who are capable of changing events or lives. At St Joes, this is achieved. The students leave better people due to the many members of the St Joes family, their education in and outside of the classroom, and the strong moral Catholic foundation that they experience.

THE STRENGTH OF A GREAT TEAM:

Scott Clough (Assistant Principal for Curriculum & Instruction), Tim Nash (Director of College & School Counseling) and Margo Sheehan (Dean of Student Life) share how they are embracing Mrs Dibugno's vision for St Joes.



Our academic curriculum is intertwined across departments and vertically aligned to build upon skills and content as students progress through disciplines. These connections result in deeper learning and student growth. As Vice Principal of Curriculum and Learning, my goal is to ensure that our students have the most robust, innovative and challenging experiences throughout their coursework.

Collaboration with College and School Counseling ensures students have diversified course offerings that not only prepares them for, but makes them desirable candidates for college admission. With our seniors reporting interest in careers in the medical field and engineering, our curriculum must respond with genetics, anatomy, robotics, coding and programming – even augmented and virtual reality opportunities. Through observations and monthly meetings, faculty share their feedback in regard to personal growth and curriculum development. Faculty work across disciplines to scaffold skills development and relate content to create opportunities for interdisciplinary learning.

Approaching curriculum in this way means that our work is never final – the St Joe's curriculum becomes a living document that is discussed, analyzed and always improving year to year.



My role as Dean of Student Life encompasses all aspects of providing a safe environment at St Joes, but my role has also evolved into a symbol of trust, understanding and accountability. I serve as a resource in partnership with our faculty and counseling office for students who may need assistance in removing barriers to success. The challenges students face during high school are diverse and may include students struggling with fitting in or adjusting to rigorous classes, for students who might want to start a new and different club but need support, for students who might be

getting bullied either in school or on social media, for students who are having a tough time at home, for students who are just shy and need help connecting with peers, for students who struggle with anxiety and need a quiet office to escape to for a few minutes.

When I discuss “the St Joes experience” with students, extracurricular involvement comes up quickly in conversation. It is a vital part of the high school experience, both for the benefits of a strong college application and also for personal growth. Clubs, immersion trips, service, internships, honor societies, the arts, and sports teach our students how to be dynamic leaders and stronger students, and more importantly, the experience helps students explore something new and build their self-confidence.

The valuable lessons that are encountered both in and out of the classroom contribute to our success in developing future leaders at St Joes. When our students learn dedication, teamwork, self-accountability and perseverance they become competitive candidates for colleges and universities. My role of Dean of Student Life is ever-changing, determined by the needs of our students; however, my responsibility in creating a safe and prospering environment for every student is paramount.



At St Joseph High School, we are fortunate to have a curriculum that challenges students at all levels, prepares them for success in higher education and offers a number of unique learning opportunities. We live the college prep strategy. The College and School Counselors know our students; and collectively, we know the colleges. The curriculum offerings, the specialized programs, the admission deadlines and programs appropriate for each student.

However, it is the solid professional relationships that we build with local and national admission leaders that ensure we stay informed about changes and requirements within the market that provide the edge in college admission. Our individual and small group meetings with students begin freshman year. As we explore student aptitude and career interest, we collaborate with administration, faculty and extracurricular program leaders to inform curriculum elevation and opportunities to build strong student resumes tailored to college admission requirements.

A Collaborative Approach to Playing at the Next Level

St Joes prides itself on having premiere academic and athletic programs that provide opportunities for our students to not only excel but to succeed at the next level. It takes a collaborative approach amongst our students, coaches, parents, faculty, counselors and staff to find the “right” college that fits the student both academically and athletically.

SJ coaches, alongside our faculty and counselors, work tirelessly with college coaches, sending out film, evaluations, grades, and skill analysis. Together with the students, we narrow down their collegial pursuits, beginning as early as freshman year. Our goal is to align our students’ academic and athletic growth toward their

college goals.

This past year, our athletes had the honor of being recruited to some of the top institutions in the country, including: College of the Holy Cross, Fairfield University, Northeastern, Syracuse, Trinity College, Tufts, and UConn. These students were recruited in ten different sports for both male and female athletic programs. They have honed their skills here at St Joes in the competitive FCIAC conference and are prepared to achieve at this next level.

With the addition of our Health and Wellness Center, St Joes students benefit from a full-time strength and conditioning coach. Our programs have developed our students to become bigger, stronger, and faster in their specific sport and has increased their recruitment profiles. The Center has also opened the door for all students, both athletes and non-athletes, in offering classes in Exercise Science, Strength and Conditioning, and Food & Nutrition. These subject areas are exposing our students to various career paths that they may like to pursue at the college and university levels.

St Joes is preparing and placing our student-athletes at post-secondary institutions where they will not only learn and excel, but will grow into fine leaders for the future and Win Everyday.

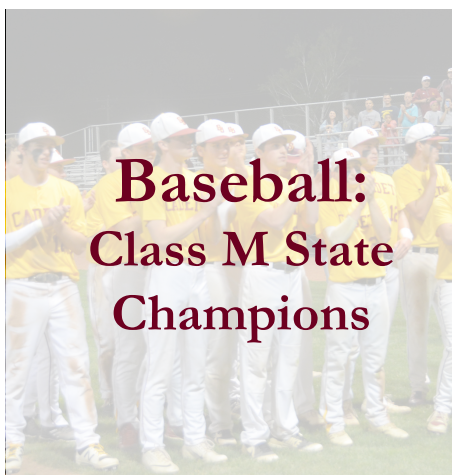

The Office of Campus Ministry seeks to provide opportunities for service that reinforce our mission and gather our community together. Most impressive is our students' willingness to serve and give back their time and talent to countless communities across Fairfield and New Haven Counties. While a service hour requirement exists for each grade level, most students go above and beyond. In the 2018-2019 academic year, students logged just over 36,000 hours of community service (well over the required 18,000 hours)!

From work with Unified Sports at IPPI Learning Academy in Stratford to volunteering at Caroline House in Bridgeport, St Joes students expand our service network each year. Grace DeDonato '22 organized a canned food drive with Spooner House in Shelton. "Operation Yes We CAN!" was launched in late May and raised over 100 bags and 900 items! Grace and her peer volunteers did incredible work and have truly embodied our call for them to be men and women for others. Each experience of service gives the St Joes student an opportunity to exercise their privilege responsibly with compassion.

In many ways, service learning provides a hands-on approach to understanding what it means to "give back". Therefore, our Christian Service Program is the essential link between what our students learn at St Joes and the meaningful ways in which they can apply that learning outside of the classroom and throughout their lives.

Visiting Rome, Italy in 2018

At Commencement this June we will again recognize students who have taken the challenge to be Francis Xavier International Scholars. These students will have participated in two or more Immersion Trips, completed advanced language courses, and taken a number of courses with an emphasis on global themes and Catholic Social Teaching.

The Francis Xavier program - 3 years strong - is open to all students, and last year more than ninety Cadets traveled to China, New Orleans, Puerto Rico, and Maine. This year there are various opportunities for each students' interest, whether domestic disaster relief, rebuilding in a rural or urban community, or exploring new cultures internationally.

During our Immersion Trips, we intentionally travel out of our every day routine to experience the lives of our sisters and brothers around the corner and around the world. We learn to walk in solidarity with those who are struggling or hurting or alone. We meet with groups to listen and learn from individuals and families that we partner with. Each trip is unique. While traveling in **China** this past year our students were able to combine meaningful history lessons, excursions to monuments, and practiced Mandarin, with conversational opportunities. Intentional experiences allow students to explore significant challenges facing our global citizenship like housing, schooling, infrastructure, and religious tolerance.

In **New Orleans** the group had the opportunity to meet with women who were rescued from human trafficking; an incredibly moving experience. A visit and lecture at the Whitney Plantation also moved the group to a better understanding of our collective history and the aftermath to families who endured years of slavery. There is still much work that needs to be done to recover from Hurricane Katrina and the group worked with an environmental sustainability organization restoring supplies for housing. A visit to the bayou with an environmental biologist intrigued the group with a better understanding of the delicate environment that sustains the wildlife and water supply to the bay area. A tour of Loyola

University and a lecture on Creationism exposed the group to topics that as a global citizen, as Pope Francis proclaims in Laudato Si needs to be, addressed if we are going to preserve our environment. Touring New Orleans the group also learned about the importance of its location as a port city, and learned about its contributions to music.

Puerto Rico proved to be just as rewarding for the group of thirty who returned to work on housing and environment clean up after Hurricane Maria. The students also had the opportunity to work at the El Yunque National Park and explored areas that are not open to the general public with their tour guides. For a few students and chaperones, this was their second trip to Puerto Rico and they could see some progress has been made with the infrastructure recovery. Roads are in better shape and electricity

is mostly restored; however, many homes are still in disrepair and they witnessed the need for sustained support. Painting, demolishing, rebuilding, clearing out and cleaning up, all much needed hands-on work. Their experience was more service, and learning how it takes a long time for a country or state to recover after a natural disaster.

Sustainable environmental practices and meeting the other person with dignity and openness is where the life lessons are experienced on Immersion Trips. Transformative life lessons are open to all students.

EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING FOR COLLEGE & BEYOND.

The Futures Internship Program is designed to provide SJ students with the opportunity to enhance their learning by exploring their career interests outside of the classroom. Interested seniors have two options. The first is to apply to be matched with an existing placement related to their interests. The second is to self-design their own internship using a connection they have established on their own. Once students are approved, participating seniors end the academic year three weeks early to leave on internship. In lieu of attending school, students work a minimum of twenty hours per week at their internship site and complete weekly journal logs about their experience.

One of the biggest challenges for a program like this is to gather a list of possible placements that includes a wide range of career paths, while also ensuring the options perfectly fit the specific needs and interests of each individual student. This is

where the SJ community stepped up, proving to be an invaluable resource and demonstrating our truly one-of-a-kind supportive, altruistic and collaborative network.

In its pilot year, our students were sent on internships in areas such as medicine, engineering, art, finance, education, and social service. With the help of our Advancement Office, we connected students with organizations such as Barnum Financial Group, Griffin Hospital, Wilton Re, Turner Construction Company, and The Connecticut Institute for Refugees and Immigrants. These internships provided seniors with valuable work experience and in a few cases, even opened the door to summer placements and other paid positions.

One of the most valuable outcomes of the program is the the students' often newfound knowledge of professional environments. With the assistance of Donna Prutting P '08, '10, '13,

'14, '16, Career Coach, students take part in workshops designed to prepare them for the transition from a classroom to a workplace. Prior to leaving on internship, these students learn the ins and outs of business etiquette and networking. These skills have given many of our students a competitive edge that will boost future job applications.

The benefits of our program were not only felt by students, but by internship sites as well. Many supervisors have expressed their satisfaction with the program and have thoroughly enjoyed the role as mentor to these young and curious minds.

Stephen is the first black officer to achieve any rank in the 126 year history of the BPD and is now one of three members of BPD's Executive Staff, which consists of two Captains and the Chief of Police.

Stephen explained, "I am proud of my accomplishments in my career and I don't shy away from the historical significance. I think it is important that people of color that reside, work or visit the City of Bristol see someone that looks like them in a leadership role of the Police Department. It is my responsibility to perform at the highest level and hopefully influence other people of color to enter a career in law enforcement."

Stephen was sworn in as a Bristol Police officer June 23, 1995. Over the past 24 years with the Bristol PD, he has held many assignments such as:

- Statewide Narcotics Task Force
- K-9 Handler
- Crisis Negotiation Team Leader
- Patrol Sergeant
- Detective Sergeant
- Lieutenant (Commander of Training/ Professional Standards Division), and now
- Captain

Stephen's ultimate goal is to become Chief of Police. He explains, "I wanted to be a Police Officer from a young age. I was mostly influenced by my best friend's father, who was a Milford, CT Police Officer.

As I got into my high school years, I became a certified EMT and volunteered for Stratford EMS. During that time I saw how much a police officer can impact someone's life. Yes, police arrest people, but I saw how police officers comfort families in times of tragedy, perform CPR or provide first aid to victims prior to EMS arriving or merely stop at a park and talk with kids playing basketball. That's what I wanted to do, catch the "bad guy", make kids smile and help those in need. My time with EMS solidified my desire to get 'on the job'."

Stephen, a member of the '88, '89 and '90 Championship Hog Football teams, carries his experience at St Joes with him, "When I reflect back on my time at SJ, it is with great fondness. I employ many of the life lessons I learned at SJ, but the one that has stuck with me comes from football. Our coaches would always say "You can't be afraid to make mistakes!" I have repeated that saying throughout my career. One has to rely on their training, education and experience to handle new or challenging situations. Basically trust yourself to do the right thing."

After graduating SJ, Stephen Tavares earned a BS from Eastern CT State University. Stephen and his wife Bridgit have two sons, Justin and Brandon.
