In addition, Wilder-Waite's 5th grade class' Project Impact will begin for the 2019/2020 school year. Project Impact is designed to help those in our community in need.

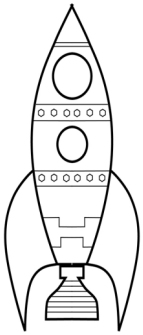

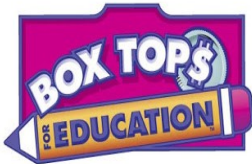
