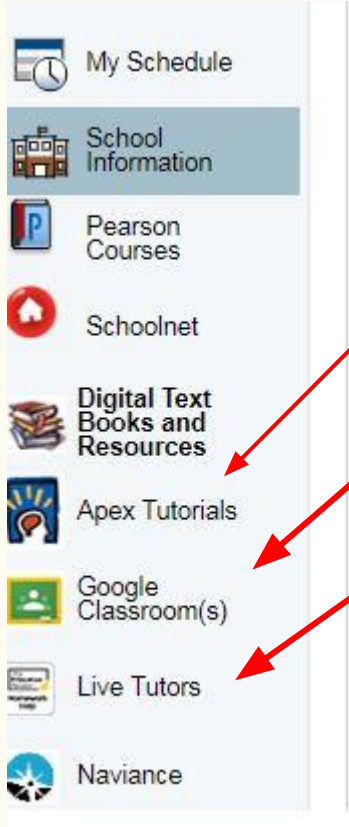

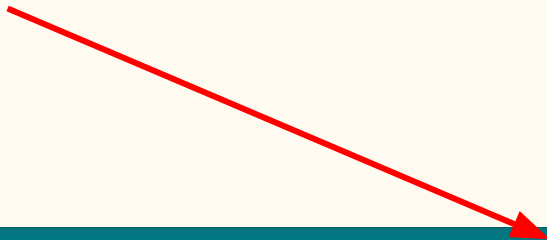

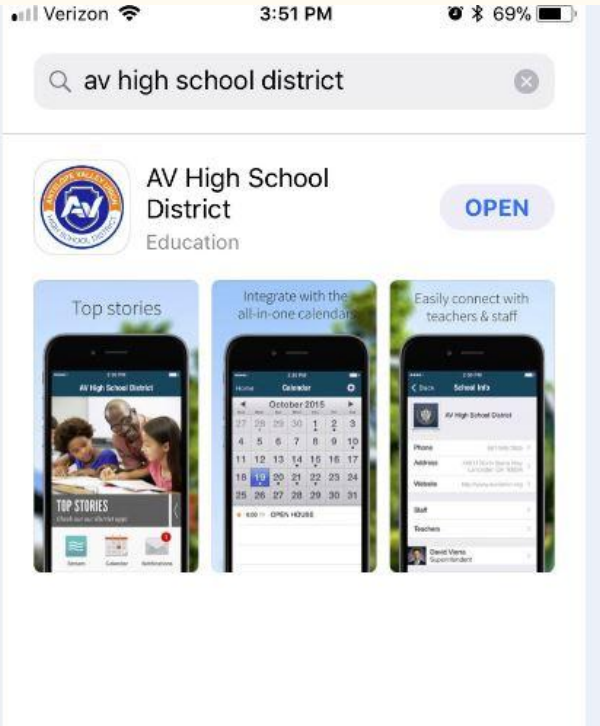

- Interpretation of PSAT/NMSQT scores (Dec)
- Naviance Exploration into Careers and Career Pathways
- Register for AVC Summer 2021& Fall 2021 (May)

Upcoming Years

11th Grade

- PSAT/NMSQT (Oct)
- SAT (Mar)
- Register for an additional SAT by June
- Exploring different colleges (College match) (1st semester)
- Financial Aid 101 (2nd semester)
- Updated Ed Plans and AVC Counselor Visit (2nd semester)

12th grade

- Take an additional SAT & ACT (Before December)
- Applying to UC/CSU's (Oct-Nov)
- Other College Applications (Nov - Jan)
- Submit FAFSA (October)
- Updated Ed Plan & visit from AVC Counselor (1st semester)
- Receive college acceptance letters (Dec - Apr)
- Receive Financial Aid Award Letters (Apr)
- College Decision Day (May 1st)
- Graduation (End of May)
