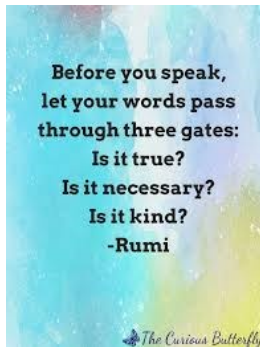

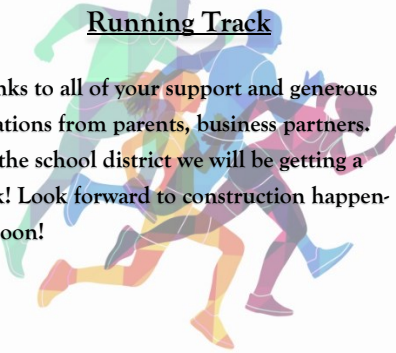


Reflection time is here again!
