Our Faculty

There are 109 full-time faculty with 66% holding advanced degrees. Students learn in an intimate environment with a student-faculty ratio of 8:1 and average class size of 13.

Community Service

Respect, reverence, and responsibility are core values of Episcopal Collegiate, and we strive to be exemplary neighbors to our community. Upper School students are required to perform community service hours in order to be promoted to the next grade level. 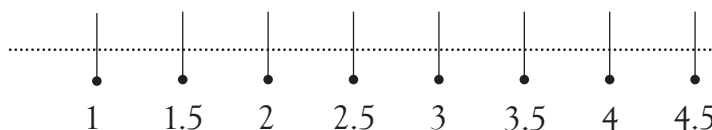

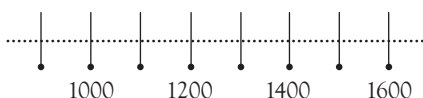


SAT® SCORES

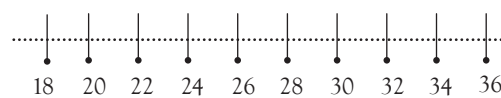


ACT® SCORES
