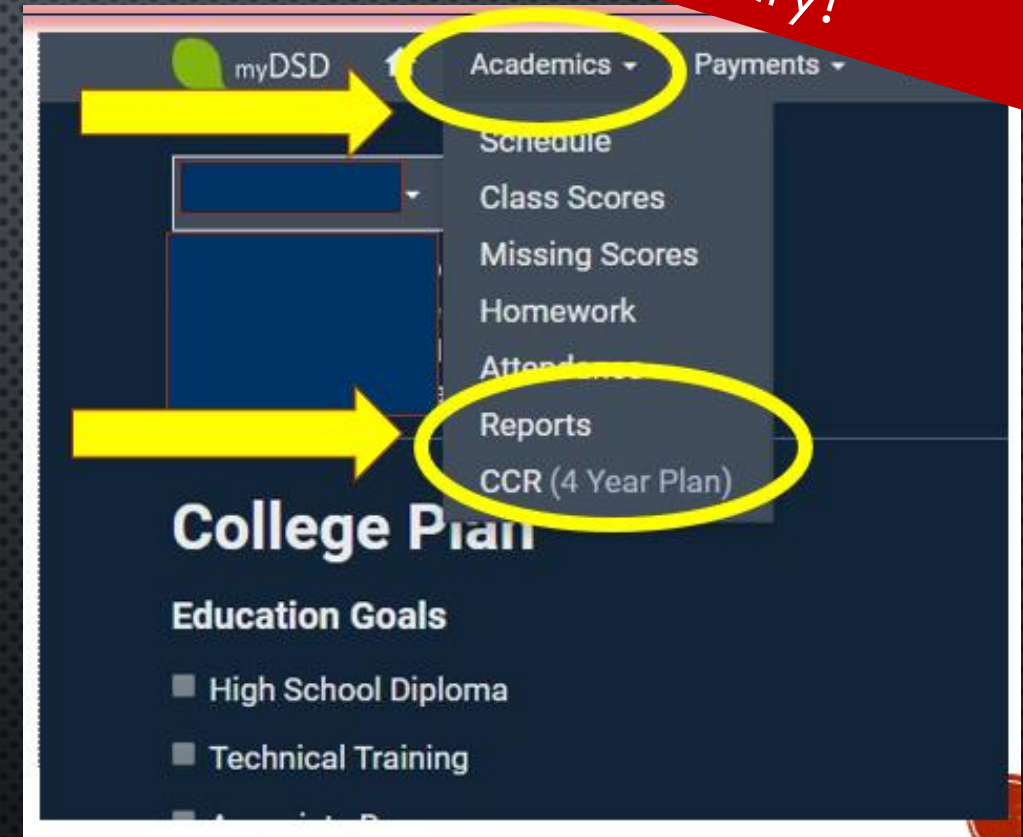



got transcripts?

- To have official transcripts sent to prospective colleges/universities, you need to fill out a **Transcript Request Form** available online or in the counseling center.

Most colleges use electronic versions



The form is titled "OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT REQUEST FORM - ELEMENTARY STUDENTS ONLY" and is for Wash County High School, 400 West 2200 South, Wash County, UT 84087. It includes contact information: Phone (801) 462-4007, Email: transcripts@washco.k12.ut.us, Fax (801) 462-4111. The form is divided into two main sections: "PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY" and "PLEASE CHECK ALL THAT APPLY". The "PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY" section includes fields for Name, Student #, and Address. The "PLEASE CHECK ALL THAT APPLY" section includes checkboxes for "I am a transcript to be sent" and "I am a transcript to be picked up in person". It also includes a list of institutions to send transcripts to, such as Utah State University, Utah State Office of Education, and various colleges. There is a section for "REGENTS SCHOLARSHIP" and a "Notes" section. The form ends with a signature line for the official and a date field.

- ✓ Every 4-year university in the US accepts the ACT (may have to do writing section)
- ✓ ACT results show you majors to consider, areas to improve & whether retesting is a good idea
- ✓ Student interests – Science Test, STEM score & English language arts score (only college admission test with all three)
- ✓ Lots of ACT prep options...see our WXHS website
- ✓ It helps colleges and scholarships find you

Regents Scholarship

Application Opens: **November 15, 2019**

Priority Deadline: **December 6, 2019**

Final Deadline: **February 3, 2020**

TIP:

Send your Regents application Certified Mail through the USPS! You will have a way to track it and have a receipt to verify they received it.


DON'T FORGET:

EDGE Scholarship


- ❖ Complete a total of 12+ credit hours of any combination of concurrent enrollment courses offered in participating Utah high schools.
- ❖ Earn a minimum 3.0 (B) cumulative grade point average on all concurrent enrollment course work.

A STUDENT RECEIVING A WSU CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT EDGE SCHOLARSHIP WILL RECEIVE A \$2,000 TUITION WAIVER PER YEAR FOR FOUR YEARS (UP TO \$1,000 PER SEMESTER FOR EIGHT SEMESTERS) REPRESENTING A TOTAL VALUE OF \$8,000.

Need a letter of recommendation?



Carefully consider who you would like to write the letter and give them plenty of time.



See form in your folder. This can help your recommender get a more complete picture of you. Use this as a working resume!



If possible, save a copy of the letter to use in the future.

NOTE: No letter of recommendation is required **or** considered for regular admission application to the University of Utah

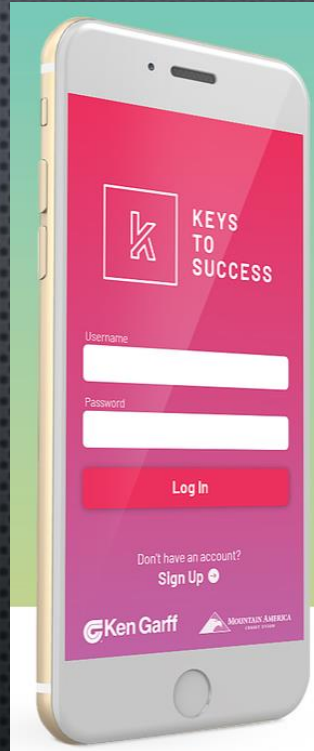

Academic Letter

The Academic Letter is the highest academic achievement awarded by Woods Cross High School.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- At least a 3.75 GPA over 6 terms (10th - 12th grade)
- Take at least 2 qualifying honors, AP, and/or CE classes (see application for list)
- At least 7 of the 8 classes taken during qualifying terms must be classes which affect the term's GPA (not pass/fail classes). Classes such as Released Time are NOT counted towards the seven. **Students who take released time AND are office/teacher aides or take directed research do NOT meet the requirements.**
