### *Student Going on Mission?*

Students planning on going on a mission before starting college should still complete college applications and secure scholarships their senior year. Students will then defer acceptance for when they return.

### *Deadlines*

Remember, students **MUST** have all components of their application submitted by the deadline. This means ACT scores, transcripts, and letters of recommendation if applicable.
