Magnificat offers a number of scholarships that honor our mission. To apply for a scholarship(s), please complete this Common Scholarship Application. You need only to complete this portion of the application once even if you apply for more than one scholarship. After that, simply answer the question(s) for the specific scholarship(s) for which you wish to apply.

Specific Requirements for all Magnificat Scholarships:

Take the HSPT exam on/or before October 26, 2019.

Complete the Common Scholarship Application.

Submit copies of your 7th grade report card and 8th grade progress report.

___ **ACADEMIC:** Magnificat offers merit-based scholarships. Students with the highest scores on the HSPT exam will qualify to apply and will be invited to interview for these scholarships simply by taking the Magnificat High School Placement Test or submitting HSPT scores to us by November 8, 2019.

___ **MARIAN:** One of our core values at Magnificat is a FAITH-FILLED LIFE. Students of all faiths and religious traditions are welcomed, supported, and respected at Magnificat. We believe that faith motivates and guides all that we do. These recipients represent the finest examples of young women living their faith. The scholarships are \$2,500 per year and will automatically renew each year, provided the recipients maintain a 3.5 GPA and remain in good disciplinary standing.

___ **ALUMNAE:** Daughters and/or granddaughters of Magnificat Alumnae and/or Lourdes Academy alumnae are eligible to apply for this scholarship on the basis of merit, service and leadership. These scholarships are \$2,500 per year and will automatically renew each year, provided the recipient maintains a 3.5 GPA and remains in good disciplinary standing.

___ **NAMED ENDOWED:** Scholarships are awarded based on a number of criteria, including financial need, academic excellence, and participation in service and leadership activities. The Lourdes Academy Alumnae Scholarship, which is open to one student in each class whose grandmother is an alumna of Lourdes Academy. Applicants for all Named Endowed Scholarships must also complete a FACTS financial aid application.

**If your daughter applies for Admission she will not need to attend an admission interview in Winter 2020.*
