Their amazing results – 216 A\* and A grades at Common Entrance, 13 scholarships and two CE prizes – tell the story of their hard work and academic journey. They are all well prepared for the next chapter in their lives.

They are both academically outstanding and part of a long tradition of excellence which has included a St Paul’s John Colet Scholarship in 2018. As you can see from the consolidated table (right), nearly 49 per cent of boys from 2010-2019 went to Eton, Dulwich, Tonbridge, Harrow, Westminster, St Paul’s, King’s College Wimbledon and Winchester and all pupils received offers to a range of top schools.

It is hard to believe that the boys leaving us in 2019 won’t sit in another maths lesson, listen to another assembly, or play together again on Clapham Common. As they head off to their next schools we ask them never to forget what they have learned here.
