### **Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees April 9, 2013**

Kathy Green, president of the Board of Trustees, called the meeting to order. The La Porte High School JROTC presented the colors and led the pledges to the American and Texas flags. The invocation was given by Vickie Gentile, principal of Bayshore Elementary School.

#### ***Recognitions***

The Board recognized La Porte ISD students who advanced to the Lee College Regional History Fair on March 23 and won awards there. Reagan Simons of the Baker Sixth Grade Campus will now advance to the state competition May 3 and 4 after winning second place in the junior individual documentary category.

Elaine Leslie and Tess Allgood, also of Baker, won fourth place in the group performance category, and Madeline Blagg, a seventh grader at La Porte Junior High, also won fourth place in the individual performance category.

Baker swept the awards in the non-progressive division, in which projects do not advance to the state competition. In the three-dimensional category, winners were Caleb Munoz, first place; Savannah Lawrence, second place; and Rachel Smith, third place. In the two-dimensional group category, Baker students Lucas Guerrero and Trent Spears won first place, and Leslie Mora and Edith Moreno won second. In the two-dimensional individual category, Caleb Lau earned first, and Emma Staes won second.
