

Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees December 13, 2016

The meeting was called to order by Dee Anne Thomson, president of the La Porte ISD Board of Trustees. Members of the La Porte High School JROTC presented the colors and led the pledges to the American and Texas flags. Dr. Larry Gerhart, principal of Lomax Junior High School, gave the invocation.

Recognitions

The La Porte ISD Business Office was recognized for receiving the Texas Association of School Business Officials Award of Merit for Purchasing and Operations. In addition, the district was also awarded Elite Status as the top submission among small districts in the state, an honor that goes to only one district in the small and large district categories.

The La Porte Education Foundation also presented two \$2,500 special campus grants as part of the 2016 grant cycle. Lomax Elementary was recognized for submitting the largest number of grant requests, and Leo A. Rizzuto Elementary was honored for being awarded the most grants. The foundation awarded 176 grants totaling \$150,600 this year.
