What is Dual Credit?

Houston Community College (HCC) provides high school students the opportunity to complete college courses for dual credit.

Any high school student or homeschooled student who is currently enrolled in 9th grade or higher may be eligible for dual credit.

Students demonstrating college readiness through a State of Texas approved college placement test can earn dual credit by taking an approved college class offered at a high school, HCC campus, or online.

Students do not have to pay tuition costs for dual credit courses. There is a fee for textbooks in some cases. At little to no cost, Houston area students can begin their college careers while still in high school.

Applying for Dual Credit Steps

1. Apply to HCC – Complete an application online at applytexas.org
2. Check eligibility and request dual credit with the High School Counselor and/or Dual Credit Liaison
3. If you do not qualify with ACT, PLAN, SAT or STAAR scores:
 - Sign up to take the TSI (Texas Success Initiative) Test through your Dual Credit office
 - Complete the TSI Pre-Assessment Activity - hccs.edu/tsi
 - Contact the High School Counselor and/or Dual Credit Liaison for TSI testing
5. Follow instructions provided by your high school to register for classes
6. When classes begin, go to myeagle.hccs.edu and click on Student Sign-In to access PeopleSoft Student and check that you are scheduled for the class. If you are not, contact your Counselor immediately.

Benefits of Dual Credit

Save Money On College Tuition

Participating students and their parents benefit by significant savings. The Houston Community College Board of Trustees waived tuition and fees for dual credit students in participating school districts.

Access To College Resources

Exposing dual credit students to the college environment – including HCC student support services – helps to ease the transition to college after high school.

Accelerate Time To Degree Completion

Dual credit students can earn up to two years of college credit related to the HCC Academic Core that can transfer to Texas public colleges and universities, private institutions, and some out-of-state colleges and universities. Students also can obtain college credit toward a Career & Technical Education (CTE)/Workforce degree.

Build Confidence

Students find that dual credit programs help establish skills to be successful in college.
