Dear Senior Parents,

Greetings! In the midst of the stress and anxiety that can often accompany the college process and senior year generally, we offer a *Day of Recollection*. A Day of Recollection is a spiritual experience that sets aside time to reflect upon the "things that matter most," a practice that can tend to be swept aside in the midst of our busy lives. It is an opportunity for self-reflection, to focus on our relationships with God and others, and to seek the Lord's will for our lives. This day is also a chance just to relax and be together with their classmates.

This year, we will be offering three options for the seniors, and the Day of Recollection itself will be "extended" until 5pm. The smaller number of students per Day of Recollection combined with a longer day enables the boys to have a much more meaningful experience! We will depart Delbarton promptly at 8:10am and return to Delbarton by 5:30pm. The Days will be held at St. Paul Inside the Walls in Madison, NJ. *The topic is "Called to True Greatness!" and the retreat will be led by the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal.* The day will include an opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation and to celebrate the Eucharist. There is no charge to you for the Day of Recollection – it is a mandatory part of your son's program and is a key component of our mission to foster the spiritual formation of our students!

At your son's orientation on August 27, he indicated his date preferences for the Day of Recollection. We had sent the dates home and they were posted on our website to facilitate this process, in an attempt to better avoid conflicts with his personal and co-curricular activities, and to limit changes to the rosters once completed. I took all of these requests into account as I formed the rosters included with this letter. However, in a number of circumstances, I needed to give a student one of his alternate choices in order to balance the Days. I tried my best to take school-related co-curricular activities into account when making these decisions. I hope your son will be satisfied with his assignment. **If there is a serious conflict with the Day of Recollection on which your son has been placed, your son is to seek out a classmate from another Day with whom he can "trade." This way the numbers on the Days will remain relatively constant. Kindly contact me as soon as a trade has been made so I can adjust my records.** If your son has a pressing reason to change his retreat, and has tried his best to make a trade but been unsuccessful, please do not hesitate to call me at ext. 3015. I'm sure we will be able to work out a solution. *As your son's Day of Recollection approaches, you will receive more retreat-specific information by way of the weekly "News from Delbarton" email.*
