

What does college cost in 2018-2019 school year?

These are the costs of colleges for a year at this time. Remember that costs are increasing each year. Multiply by the number of years you will be in school.



Private schools:

Baylor - \$42,842 tuition, + \$16,890 for fees, room and board

\$59,732/year, \$238,928/4 years

TCU - \$46,950 tuition, + \$13,754 for fees, room and board

\$60,704/year, \$242,816/4 years

Rice - \$46,600 tuition, + \$14,750 for fees, room and board

\$61,350/year, \$245,400/4 years

SMU - \$48,364 tuition, + \$23,954 for fees, room and board

\$72,318/year, \$289,272/4 years

Public State schools:

A&M – \$10,403 tuition + \$10,368 room and board + \$5,756 other

\$26,527/year, \$106,108/4 years

UT - \$10,136 tuition, + \$15,042 fees, room and board

\$25,178/year, \$100,712/4 years

UNT – \$8,103 tuition + \$12,709 fees and room and board

\$20,812/year, \$83,248/4 years

Texas Tech - \$8,428 tuition, + \$14,701 for fees, room and board

\$23,129/year, \$92,516/4 years

UTA - \$10,742 tuition and fees, + \$11,262 other

\$22,004 if you live on campus/year, \$88,016/4 years
