Co-Curricular and Enrichment Activities

We offer here at Roedean Moira House an exciting daily and weekend extra-curricular programme. The programme offers something for each girl in the school, to try out new experiences and find their special talents. The extra co-curricular and enrichment programme helps girls to enrich their development and their confidence, and also learn how to work within a team within different year groups. We have specialist teachers to coach for activities such as archery and fencing.

- We offer extra co-curricular activities every day in the afternoon, from Reception – Year 13.
- Girls can choose a variety of exciting activities each term as outlined in the Co-curricular booklet.
- Activities change from term to term.
- At the end of each term, a letter is sent with to all parents informing them of what is on offer for the following term.
- Once the girls have made their choice of activity for the term, they are encouraged not to change their chosen activity until the end of term.
- Girls from Reception –Years 11 select one activity per day.
- Girls in Years 12-13 should select at least three activities per week.
- We also run a Community programme for years 12-13 once a week.
- The cost per term/session for each activity can be found in the Co-curricular booklet.
- There are a number of activities which are very popular with the girls, and on occasion it may not be possible to join, in this case your daughter will be added to a waiting list for the following term. There is a limit on numbers for some activities.
