Welcome, previous minutes read.

Principal Larsen discussed the School Improvement Plan (SIP) Goals with the council.

### Goal #1 Student Achievement

The goal was to increase the percent of K-6 student scoring at or above benchmark on middle of the year DIBLES Composite Score by 2%.

In 2016-2017 88% of students were proficient at meeting MOY DIBLES Benchmarks. Our current year number stayed at 88% so this goal is not progressing according to plan

### Goal #2 College, Career and Community Readiness

Third through sixth grades have increased their SAGE Writing Benchmark score by 5% from the beginning of the year to middle of the year so this goal is progressing according to plan.

### Goal #3

All classroom teachers will be learning and implementing the six key dimensions for 21<sup>st</sup> Century Learning through the Microsoft Educator Community. Teachers will also implement the Blended Learning with students to enrich and engage student learning through multiple platforms of technology.

### Goal #4

100% of teachers will be trained in implementation of Project Lead the Way. Additionally, 100% of students will participate in one Project Lead the Way Module. This goal has been accomplished.

### Goal #5

Students will reduce chronic absenteeism by 2% (from 9% to 7%)

Unfortunately chronic absenteeism increased from 9% to 16% and this goal did not progress according to plan.
