

During October we will focus on our second habit, "Begin with the End in Mind." Mrs. Daly and I have been introducing this habit to the students in all grade levels. We talked to the students about setting goals and thinking about what they want to have happen in the future. It relates to all areas of students' lives, whether it's planning out how to get an assignment done, or practicing to develop different skills in sports, language, friendship, etc. or planning for their future lives. We were happy to find that students could tell us about the first habit "Be Proactive" and have been demonstrating this habit at school.

### **Mindful Schools Lesson 3**


COUNSELOR'S

Today was our third mindfulness lesson. We learned about Heartfulness - Sending Kind Thoughts.

Heartfulness is all about cultivating compassion for ourselves and for others. We practiced this by learning to send Kind Thoughts to another person and to ourselves. These kind thoughts may be phrases such as "May you be healthy and strong," "May you be happy," 'May you be peaceful," or other phrases you come up with on your own.

- ◆ Invite your child to teach you how to Send Kind Thoughts to another person. Practice this with them for one minute.
- ◆ Practice Sending Kind Thoughts to others and to yourself throughout the day.




First 50 students registered in the office for each session will be enrolled! Students may enroll for both sessions.

Hello Heritage Families,






