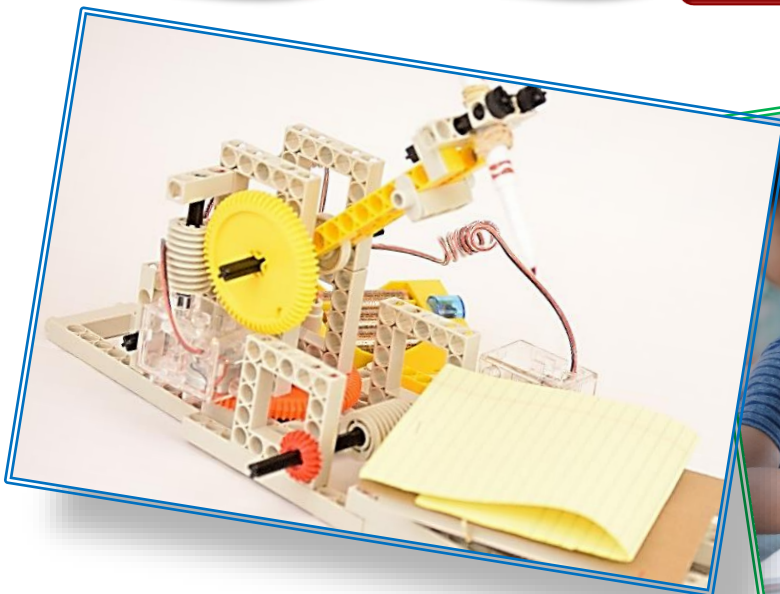


Image description: Example of a project built during the program.
