

Who provides my busing?

YOUR HOMETOWN PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT works directly with the bus companies to provide transportation for RBC. In some cases, MOESC - Monmouth Ocean Educational Services Commission - will be given the responsibility to configure the routes. The phone number for MOESC is **732-389-5555**

Criterion:

The criteria to receive busing to Red Bank Catholic is that **you must live 2.5 miles or more and under 20 miles** from school. RBC **does not** make any final decisions on busing.

What do I do if I move?

If you **move** at *any time* during the calendar year, you must come to the RBC Business Office to fill out a new transportation form as well as a Change of Address form for your student.

When listening for the announcement of RBC school closing, you should also be listening for your busing district closing to see if you will or will not have transportation.

Does RBC have delayed openings?

While RBC does not have delayed openings, we follow your local district direction. If the district from which you are bused has a delayed opening, your bus will be delayed accordingly and RBC will honor these delays.

If your district is closed, your student will be marked absent but will be excused.
