

THE DANGERS OF VAPING: WHAT EVERY PARENT NEEDS TO KNOW

A Panel Discussion Presented by the Family Outreach Committee of UCF Schools



A national survey of 42,531 8th–12th graders found that 25.4% of high-school seniors had vaped nicotine in the last month, as well as 20.2% of 10th graders and 9% of 8th graders.

As of Sept. 24, officials counted at least 805 confirmed and probable cases of vaping-related illness reported by 46 states, according to the CDC. At least twelve deaths have been confirmed in 10 states.

In response to growing concerns from our community at large about the dangers of vaping and electronic cigarettes, FOCUS is partnering with Unionville-Chadds Ford School District Administration as well as a variety of local health and substance abuse professionals to deliver an informational panel presentation and discussion for UCFSF parents.
