Proposed Goals:

1. Increase the percentage of K-3 students scoring at or above DIBELS beginning-of-year composite score benchmark by 12% by end of year benchmark assessment.
 - a. Increase the coordination between TAs intervention and classroom intervention
2. Using positive behavior management and reinforcement systems we will decrease the number of students who have more than 3 documented office referrals by 12%.
 - a. Admin to identify repeat offenders from years previous, and make a plan to build relationship, teach, and intervene.
 - b. Faculty to identify what will be considered a document office referral
3. Students will develop mathematical and science habits of mind by engaging in problem solving activities and communicating about mathematics reasoning. Achievement will be evidenced by administrative observation using the Evaluate Davis teacher observation tool and through 3 lesson studies.
 - a. Teacher given quarterly planning day to plan using CMI principles with grade level team.
4. Teachers will implement the professional learning community (PLC) process by frequently (at least weekly) meeting with grade level team members to discuss students' achievement data, drive instruction, and develop common assessments.
 - a. Math coach to be a part of PLC attendance
