## **Data Dive:**

Our free and reduced lunch is at about 36%, it needs to be at 40% to receive Title 1 funding. These results are confidential.

CRT (end of year) data from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade were 92% proficient in reading and 89% proficient in math.

Acadience reading information 72% at or above benchmark.

Students with disabilities are not making as much progress as we'd like for them to make. (according to acadience data).

English language learners had very similar data- about 32% at or above benchmark.

USBE- Sage (State report card)- Typical achievement. ELA 49.7%, Math 52.4%, Science 54.8%.

USBE- Sage (State report card)- Typical growth. ELA 46.9%, Math 51.4%, Science 51.3%.

USBE- Sage (State report card)- Science achievement is good, however our progress is lower and we'd like to see that come up. Our math is great!

Sage- Compared students year to year, lowest 25% of students still made growth.

According to School Improvement Plan:

Goal #1: K-3 students will make typical or better growth on Acadience middle of year (from 63% to 66%)

Goal #2: increase progress of English language learners.

Goal #3: increase student progress in science.

Goal #4: Students with disabilities will increase progress/growth from 29.27% to 36%.
