## STUDENTS AND PARENTS ~ PLEASE READ AND INITIAL THE POLICY AND GUIDELINES DEFINED BELOW AND COMPLETE ALL THE QUESTIONS, WITH SIGNATURES, <u>BEFORE</u> YOU PURCHASE TICKETS. THIS FORM MUST BE TURNED IN FOR ALL PARTIES WHEN TICKETS ARE PURCHASED.

**BAGS AND OPEN CONTAINERS**: Open containers of any kind will not be allowed into the dance. All bags brought to the dance are subject to search.

**CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES**: Any Beaverton High School student, or guest, found in possession or under the influence of alcohol or a controlled substance will be referred to school authorities. Violation of the above will result in disciplinary action in accordance with the Beaverton Disciplinary Code. All BHS students and guests will be asked to submit to a brief breathalyzer test before entering the dance. (see reverse side for details)

**INAPPROPRIATE DANCING**: Freaking, grinding, twerking and other sexual dancing is inappropriate at BHS dances. Students who choose to dance in this manner <u>will</u> be removed from the dance, parents will be notified.

**DANCE ATTIRE:** No sunglasses or sweats are allowed at BHS dances. All dresses must be a minimum of mid-thigh length. Please ensure that all attire is appropriate for a high school dance.

The safety and security of every student is one of our highest priorities at Beaverton High School. We work to create a climate that is welcoming and supportive, while at the same time safe and secure. The activities and events throughout the year, ranging from the day-to-day academics to our extra-curricular athletics and activities, are an important part of our atmosphere and we encourage all students to participate.

Because we truly strive to create the safest environment possible, we have several precautionary steps that we take at our dances. At Homecoming, Sadie Hawkins and Prom we already have the following in place:

- We check the identification of every student and guest upon entrance,
- We check through purses and backpacks,
- We don't allow opened containers of liquid into the dance, and
- We require all guests to complete a guest pass prior being able to attend.

We have one more safety measure to our dance procedures. To encourage good decision making on the part of all our students and guests, we will ask each student to quickly breathe into a breathalyzer before entering the dance. Students who do not pass the initial breathalyzer test will meet with our School Community Resource Officer for further review.

We want everyone who attends a BHS dance to have an enjoyable time. In addition, we want all students so be safe on their way to, while in attendance at, and on their way home from the dances. We believe that the breathalyzer test will further support our demand of excellence from our school community and will increase our overall safety.
