

## **The Education Improvement Grant (EIG)**

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EIG is focused upon :

- Improving the quality of teaching and learning
- Addressing learners' barriers to learning and improving inclusion
- Improving the leadership of educational settings
- Improving the provision for learners and the engagement of learners.

2019-2020 Allocation is : £210,000

This expenditure is directed towards partial costs for :

- Reduced Teaching Timetables

## **Pupil Deprivation Grant (PDG)**

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PDG should be used to focus on improving the attainment of children from deprived backgrounds, specifically those who are eFSM and for our early years grant, to ensure pupils are 'school ready' on completion of their stage.

2019-2020 PDG Allocation is : £298,010

2019-2020 Early Years PDG Allocation is : £32,899

- Full time teacher and full time provision of 2 nursery classes
