ACTION ITEMS

1. Senior Portrait Deadline Fast Approaching - October 25, 2019 The deadline for receipt of senior portrait photos for the yearbook

Families must follow the quality and sizing guidelines which are given to us by our printing company.

4) National PSAT Wednesday Plans - October 16

High schools across the country, including all 4 Northshore comprehensive high schools, will be giving the PSAT on Wednesday October 16. This will mean a all students have a different schedule for October 16 than usual. Details are below:

10th and 11th Graders

- Almost all 10th and 11th graders in Northshore take the PSAT
- Very few "opt out" and those receiving Special Education services have alternate plans (for the most part a few of our kids receiving Special Education services do take the PSAT)

9th Graders

- Some 9th graders elect to take the test even though it is not designed for 9th graders
- The overwhelming majority of 9th graders will have a 4-part experience on PSAT Day:
 - Part 1: An assembly on making every student feel welcome, valued and included (with guest presenter Erin Jones)
 - Part 2: How to stay "cyber safe" in this age of digital media
 - Part 3: How to stay healthy in this age of teen vaping and drug use
 - Part 4: How to stay academically honest (a session on how to avoid plagiarism etc.)

12th Graders

- This is a special day for Seniors! They have many fun (and some mandatory) events to attend
- We start off with a special "Seniors Only" Pancake Breakfast for the seniors cooked by staff and parents!!!
- It's followed by a **mandatory Senior Class Meeting** where seniors will work with Jostens to design their **Graduation Announcements** and determine what their **Commencement Tassel** looks like
- That is followed by a **mandatory session with Counselors** so that all seniors complete the State Graduation Requirement of finishing their **High School and Beyond Plan**
- After these sessions, seniors will review the Senior Timeline and will participate in the 1st Annual (the 1st ever) **Commitment to Graduate Assembly**
- Once the assembly ends, Seniors will head off to lunch and then Advisory to finish out the early release Wednesday
- If your Senior is in Running Start or WaNIC, please alert them to this day and check to see if they might be able to attend. If not, information will be available in the Counseling Center for Running Start students (who still have to do a High School and Beyond plan).
