Tips for the Doctor's Office

- Have the conversation up-front with your doctor confirming your exam is preventive, for example, your annual physical or preventive colonoscopy.
- Always ask questions about what your options are in the exam room. For example, are there less invasive treatment options
 available to consider when contemplating surgery. You always have a right to a second opinion.
- Don't be afraid to pause in the office and shop for where you are being referred use the cost estimator online or on your mobile app to find the least expensive MRI, for example.
- Validate the prescription is on the Aetna Standard formulary, and inquire about generic alternatives (at the office, on your phone, or at the pharmacy)
- Only use the ER for emergencies. Visit an urgent care center or walk-in clinic for non-life threatening medical issues instead of the hospital emergency room.

You can request visits three ways: online, via the Teladoc app or by phone. You can speak to a doctor "on demand" in minutes.* Or schedule a time that's more convenient for you. We know urgent care and emergency room visits can be costly and time-consuming. Teladoc visits are never more than \$40. Find out more and set up your Teladoc account at **teladoc.com/aetna**.

*Ten minutes is the median wait time for an on-demand visit, but wait times may be longer during peak hours or seasons. On-demand consults are guaranteed within an hour of request or are free of charge. Idaho is video only; Arkansas and Delaware require video for the first visit every 24 months.

A convenient and affordable way to provide care

A caregiver for a loved one has enough things to worry about. Medical care doesn't have to be one of them. The Teladoc caregiver service allows you, as a Teladoc member, to add a nonmember to your existing Teladoc account to receive care. It works like this:

- You can initiate a two- or three-way video or phone visit with a doctor, yourself (the caregiver) and the care recipient (nonmember).
- This is a direct-to-consumer service through Teladoc that Aetna allows you to access. It's not an Aetna® benefit and is independent of your Aetna medical benefits plan.
- This service is available for the general medical Teladoc services only (not for behavioral health or dermatology).

You can search for covered medicines at **aetnapharmacy.com/standard**. The codes you get from the search tell you what you need to do.

- "PA" means your doctor may need to get our approval ahead of time before we will cover certain medicines.
- "ST" means you may need to try equally effective but less costly medicines first before we will cover some medicines.
- "NC" means that the medicine is not covered. Click on the therapeutic class to see covered alternatives.

MemberFrequently Asked Questions

What is Teladoc?

Teladoc provides 24/7 access to U.S. board-certified doctors by phone or video for many non-emergency illnesses, including flu, allergies, sinus infections, and more.

Who are the Teladoc doctors?

Teladoc doctors are licensed internists, family doctors, and pediatricians. They average 20 years of experience and are licensed to practice in your state.

Does Teladoc replace my doctor?

No. Teladoc doesn't replace your primary care doctor. Teladoc should be used for non-emergency illnesses when it is not convenient to get to the doctor or it is outside of regular office hours.

How do I talk to a Teladoc doctor?

You can connect with a doctor via phone or video.

How do I set up my Teladoc account?

Visit the website listed below and click "Member Login." You can also download the mobile app or call the number below.

How do I request a visit?

Log in to your account online or via the app and click "Request a Consult." You can also request a visit by calling the number below.

Is there a time limit when talking with a doctor?

There is no time limit for visits.

Am I charged more for talking longer?

There is no extra charge for longer doctor visits.

Can Teladoc doctors write a prescription?

Yes, Teladoc doctors can prescribe medication when medically necessary.

How do I pay for the visit?

You can pay with your HSA (health savings account) card, credit card, prepaid debit card, or by PayPal.

If the Teladoc doctor recommends that I see my primary care doctor or a specialist, do I still have to pay the Teladoc consult fee?

Yes. Just like any doctor appointment, you must pay for the consulting doctor's time.

Can my primary care doctor get a record of my Teladoc visit?

With your consent, we'll send an electronic copy of your Teladoc visit to your primary care doctor.

Be proactive about your health

Prevention is the best medicine

When your doctor diagnoses a health condition early, you may be able to delay or even prevent its problems. Getting early treatment can make your condition easier to manage and put you in control of your health.

Your doctor plays a key role in your care

They may suggest:

- **Screening tests**, which find health problems before symptoms appear
- **Diagnostic tests, physicals and self-exams,** which find health problems early in their course

Your doctor may also use guidelines to recommend screenings based on your age, health, gender, lifestyle habits, family history and, if you're a woman, on whether you are preparing for pregnancy.

If you're thinking about getting a test, it's a good idea to talk with your doctor about what the test is, what it costs and what happens if you need further testing. Together, decide what's right for you.

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Screenings for adults

Adult screenings are intended to find health issues as you age. And many are part of your annual preventive exam.* Talk with your doctor about which screenings are right for you.

Preventive screening	Group	Recommendation
Alcohol and tobacco use	Everyone	Annually
Blood pressure	Everyone	Annually
Breast cancer	Women, aged 50 – 74	Mammogram every 2 years. Talk with your doctor to decide if you need them more often.
Cervical cancer	Women, beginning at age 21	Pap smear for women 21 – 65 years of age every 3 years. Women 30 – 65 years of age may have a Pap smear and human papillomavirus (HPV) testing every 5 years. ²
Cholesterol	Everyone, beginning at age 35	Annually
Colorectal cancer	Everyone, beginning at age 45	Every 10 years. Talk to your doctor.
Depression	Everyone	Annually
Diabetes	Everyone	Glucose test every 3 years. Talk to your doctor if you are at increased risk.
Lung cancer	Current or former smokers, aged 55 – 80**	Annually
Osteoporosis	Women, under age 65	Every 2 years for postmenopausal women at increased risk for osteporosis
Sexually transmitted diseases	Everyone	Annually
Vision	Everyone	Annually
Weight	Everyone	Annually

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Good news — your health benefits and insurance plan cover the services listed here with no cost share* as part of preventive care.

^{*}Employers with grandfathered plans may choose not to cover some of these preventive services or to include cost share (deductible, copay or coinsurance) for preventive care services. Certain religious employers and organizations may choose not to cover contraceptive services as part of the group health coverage. Preventive care at no cost share covered in accordance with the Affordable Care Act.

Coverage includes routine screenings and checkups.

It also includes counseling you get to prevent illness, disease or other health problems.

Many of these services are covered as part of physical exams. These include regular checkups, routine gynecological exams and wellness exams for children. You won't have to pay out of pocket for these preventive visits when they are provided in network.

But these services are generally not preventive if you get them as part of a visit to diagnose, monitor or treat an illness or injury. In these cases, copays, coinsurance and deductibles may apply.

Aetna follows the recommendations of national medical societies about how often children, men and women need these services. Be sure to talk with your doctor about which services are right for your age, gender and health status.

Covered preventive services for adults generally include:

Screenings for:

- Abdominal aortic aneurysm (one-time screening for men of specified ages who have ever smoked)
- · Alcohol misuse
- · High blood pressure screening
- · Cholesterol (for adults of certain ages or at higher risk)
- Colorectal cancer (for adults over age 50)
- Depression
- Type 2 diabetes (for adults with high blood pressure)
- Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV)
- Obesity
- Prostate cancer (for men ages 40 and older)
- Tobacco use
- Lung cancer (for adults ages 55 and over with a history of smoking)
- Syphilis (for all adults at higher risk)
- Hepatitis B surface antigen (effective 1/1/2019)

Medicine and supplements:

- Aspirin up to 81 mg for women up to the age of 45 at risk of preeclampsia and up to 81 mg for men and women from age 50 to 69 with certain cardiovascular risk factors
- Tobacco-cessation medicine approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA), including over-thecounter medicine when prescribed by a health care provider and filled at a participating pharmacy
- Bowel preparation medication (for preventive colorectal cancer screening)
- Low dosage statins: simvastatin 5/10 mg and atorvastatin 10 mg. Covered for members from age 40 to 75 with no history of cardiovascular disease (CVD), one or more CVD risk factors and a calculated ten-year CVD event risk of 10 percent or greater

Counseling for:

- · Alcohol misuse
- Domestic violence
- Nutritional diet (for adults with hyperlipidemia and other known risk factors for cardiovascular and diet-related chronic disease)
- Obesity
- Sexually transmitted infection (STI) prevention (for adults at higher risk)
- Tobacco use (including programs to help you stop using tobacco)

Immunizations:

Doses, recommended ages and recommended populations vary.

- Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis (Tdap)
- · Hepatitis A and B
- Herpes zoster
- Human papillomavirus (HPV)
- Influenza
- Measles, mumps, rubella (MMR)
- Meningococcal (meningitis)
- Pneumococcal (pneumonia)
- Varicella (chickenpox)

Covered preventive services for women

Screenings and counseling for:

- BRCA (counseling and genetic testing for women at high risk with no personal history of breast and/or ovarian cancer)
- Breast cancer chemoprevention (for women at higher risk)
- Breast cancer (mammography every one to two years for women over 40)
- Cervical cancer (for sexually active women)
- Chlamydia infection (for younger women and other women at higher risk)
- Gonorrhea (for all women at higher risk)
- Interpersonal or domestic violence
- Osteoporosis (for women over age 60 depending on risk factors)

Medicine and supplements:

- Folic acid supplements (for women of childbearing ages)
- Risk-reducing medicine such as tamoxifen and raloxifene for women ages 35 and older at increased risk for breast cancer

Contraceptive products and services*:

- Prescribed FDA-approved female over-the-counter or generic contraceptives** when filled at a network pharmacy
- Two visits a year for patient education and counseling on contraceptives
- Voluntary sterilization services

Covered preventive services for pregnant women

- Routine prenatal visits (you pay your normal cost share for delivery, postpartum care, ultrasounds or other maternity procedures, specialist visits and certain lab tests)
- Anemia screenings
- Diabetes screenings
- Bacteriuria urinary tract or other infection screenings
- Rh incompatibility screening, with follow-up testing for women at higher risk
- Hepatitis B counseling (at the first prenatal visit)
- Expanded counseling on tobacco use
- Maternal depression screening

 Breastfeeding interventions to support and promote breastfeeding after delivery, including up to six visits with a lactation consultant

Covered preventive supplies for pregnant women

- Certain standard electric breastfeeding pumps (nonhospital grade) anytime during pregnancy or while you are breastfeeding, once every three years
- Manual breast pump anytime during pregnancy or after delivery for the duration of breastfeeding
- Breast pump supplies if you get pregnant again before you are eligible for a new pump

Screenings and assessments for:

- Alcohol and drug use (for adolescents)
- Autism (for children at 18 and 24 months)
- Behavioral/psychosocial issues

- Development screening (for children under age 3, and surveillance throughout childhood)
- Hearing (newborns and adolescents)
- Height, weight and body mass index
- Lipid disorders (dyslipidemia screening for children at higher risk)
- · Hematocrit or hemoglobin
- Hemoglobinopathies or sickle cell (for newborns)
- Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) (for adolescents at higher risk)

Exclusions and limitations

This plan does not cover all health care expenses and includes exclusions and limitations. - All medical and hospital services not specifically covered in, or which are limited or excluded by, your plan documents, including costs of services before coverage begins and after coverage terminates
- Cosmetic surgery
- · Custodial care
- Dental care and dental X-rays

- · Donor egg retrieval
- · Durable medical equipment
- Experimental and investigational procedures (except for coverage for medically necessary routine patient care costs for members participating in a cancer clinical trial)
- Hearing aids
- · Home births
- · Immunizations for travel or work
- Implantable drugs and certain injectable drugs including injectable infertility drugs
- Infertility services including, but not limited to, artificial insemination and advanced reproductive technologies such as in vitro fertilization (IVF), zygote intrafallopian transfer (ZIFT), gamete intrafallopian transfer (GIFT), intracytoplasmic sperm injection (ICSI) and other related services unless specifically listed as covered in your plan documents
- Nonmedically necessary services or supplies
- Orthotics except diabetic orthotics
- Outpatient prescription drugs (except for treatment of diabetes), unless covered by a prescription plan rider and over-the-counter medicine (except as provided in a hospital) and supplies
- · Radial keratotomy or related procedures
- Reversal of sterilization
- Services for the treatment of sexual dysfunction or inadequacies, including therapy, supplies or counseling
- Special-duty nursing
- Therapy or rehabilitation other than what is listed as covered in the plan documents
- Weight-control services including surgical procedures, medical treatments, weight-control/loss programs, dietary regimens and supplements, appetite suppressants and other medicine, food or food supplements, exercise programs, exercise or other equipment, and other services and supplies that are primarily intended to control weight or treat obesity, including morbid obesity, or for the purpose of weight reduction, regardless of the existence of comorbid conditions

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
